The Borough Council of Sandwell (Long Stay On-Street Pay and Display Parking) (Wednesbury and West Bromwich) Order 2023

The Borough Council of Sandwell ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 45 and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and under the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended ("the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Sandwell (Long Stay On-Street Pay and Display Parking) (Wednesbury and West Bromwich) Order 2023 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them: -

"Authorised Person"	means an employee or agent of the Council authorised to exercise all or any of the functions of the Council under this Order.
"Council"	means Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council;
"Civil Enforcement Officer"	means an Authorised Person by or on behalf of the Council to enforce the restrictions in this Order and issue penalty contravention notices,
"Disabled Person's	has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)
Badge"	(England) Regulations 2000;
"Driver"	in relation to a Motor Vehicle waiting in a parking area, means the person driving the Motor Vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place.
"Electric Vehicle"	means a vehicle in which the electrical motive power is derived from an electrical storage battery which is not connected to any source of power when the vehicle is in motion;
"Motor Vehicle"	has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;

"Parking Disc"	has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 which is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun;
"Parking Ticket"	means a ticket lawfully obtained from a Ticket Machine provided by the Council for the issue of Parking Tickets appropriately dated and time stamped relating to Schedule 1B of this Order.
"Parking Place"	Mean the part of the road authorised by the Order to be used for the purposes of parking Motor Vehicle.
"Permit"	means a Permit issued by the Council under the provisions of this Order;
"Relevant Position"	 in respect of: - (a) a Disabled Person's Badge and Parking Disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and (b) a Permit means exhibited behind the windscreen, on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the Permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle; c) A Parking Disc is displayed in the "Relevant Position" if – the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle, or where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, so that, when marked to show the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.
"Restricted Hours"	means in relation to any Restricted Road the hours during which waiting is restricted;

"Restricted Road"	means any of the sides or lengths of roads where waiting is restricted or specific activities are restricted during the Restricted Hours provided that the expression "Restricted Road" shall not include any Parking Place;
"Ticket Machine"	means an approved ticket issuing machine provided by the Council for the issue of Parking Tickets appropriately dated and time stamped.
"Traffic Sign"	means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
"Universal Service Provider"	has the same meaning given by Section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011.

- 3. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Clause shall, unless the context requires otherwise, be construed as a reference to the Clause bearing that number in this Order.
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

PAY AND DISPLAY

- 5. Except as provided for in Clause 6, the parts of roads specified in Schedule 1A to this Order are authorised to be used for the purposes of parking a Motor Vehicle displaying a valid Parking Ticket (obtained in accordance with Clause 11) and subject to the following provisions of this section, as a Parking Place for such classes of Motor Vehicles in such positions as specified in Schedule 1A and during the hours prescribed in Column 5 in the said schedule.
- 6. "For the purposes of Clause 5, a further contravention shall be created if the Motor Vehicle remains on a length of road at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the Order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period."
- 7. Nothing in Clause 5, shall restrict the power of the Council or a person designated by the Council to suspend the use of the Parking Place or any part thereof whenever he/she considers such suspension reasonably necessary -
 - (a) for the purposes of facilitating the movement to traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) to enable a Motor Vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with
 - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
 - ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - iii) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication lawfully kept installed in any position;
 - iv) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1A of this Order;
 - c) for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository;
 - (d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a Motor Vehicle;
 - (e) to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/Civil Enforcement Officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
 - (f) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions; provided that the Authorised Person by the Council to suspend the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof, shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that Parking Place or part thereof, the use of which is suspended, a Traffic Sign indicating that waiting by Motor Vehicles is prohibited.
- 8. No Motor Vehicle shall be permitted to wait in the Parking Place :-

- (a) when the Council has suspended or suspended part of that Parking Place in accordance with the provisions Clause 7;
- (b) For a period exceeding the length of time specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1A; even if the charges for that parking space have been temporarily suspended.
- (c) If there is an interval of less than the duration specified in Column 7 of Schedules 1A from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same side and length of road.
- 9. Nothing in Clauses 5 or 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with
 - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
 - ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - iii) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication lawfully kept installed in any position;
 - iv) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1A of this Order;
 - (c) to enable a vehicle which is a Universal Service Provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.
 - (d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (e) to enable a Motor Vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duty.
- 10. Where the Parking Place is marked by signs, lines, studs or other indications so as to indicate its provision as a Parking Place for Motor Vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the Driver of a Motor Vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the Parking Place unless it is -
 - (a) of the specified class and
 - (b) in the specified position except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
- 11. Except as provided in Clause 14, the following provisions relate to all Motor Vehicles having more than 2 wheels.
 - (a) Subject as hereinafter provided the Driver of a Motor Vehicle waiting in a Parking Place specified in Schedule 1A to this Order, during the hours specified in Column 5 in the said schedule, on leaving the Motor Vehicle in that Parking Place, must pay the daily charges specified in Schedule 1B, by the insertion of a coin or coins for the period required into the

Ticket Machine approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Act of 1984, shall apply in respect of such apparatus namely:-

- i) Parking Places specified in Schedule 1A to this Order- For any one visit charges as specified in Schedule 1B to this Order.
- (b) Any ticket issued in receipt of payment of the charges referred to in Clause 11(a), shall be displayed in a conspicuous position in the Motor Vehicle in respect of which it was issued and shall continue to be displayed in such conspicuous position during the whole of the time that the Motor Vehicle remains in the Parking Place, so that it can be read by any Parking Attendant carrying out his normal enforcement duties.
- (c) Following the issue and display of a ticket in accordance with Clauses 11 (a) and (b) no further ticket shall be purchased and displayed in the same vehicle whilst parked in the same side and length of road. This clause shall apply if the vehicle has remained in the Parking Place and shall also apply if it has returned to the same Parking Place after an interval of less than the duration specified in Column 7 of Schedule 1A from a previous period of waiting in the same side and length of road.
- (d) Nothing in Clause 11 (c) shall apply if the additional ticket or tickets purchased bear an expiry time not later than the length of time specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1A after the time of purchase of the initial ticket issued in accordance with Clause 11 (a).
- (e) Any vehicle using the Parking Place shall wait wholly within a designated bay.
- 12. The particulars as to the time at which a ticket or tickets were obtained from the apparatus or device provided specified on the ticket or tickets issued by the apparatus or device and affixed in accordance with the provisions of Clause 11 shall be evidence of the particulars so specified.
- 13. No person shall use any Parking Ticket or tickets issued in respect of a Motor Vehicle left in a Parking Place specified in Clause 5 in relation to any other Motor Vehicle.
- 14. Nothing in Clause 11 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle which displays:-
 - (a) a Disabled Person's Badge, in the Relevant Position, to wait in the sides of lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1A.
- 15. Where there is no functioning Ticket Machine payment must be made by other means as advertised by the Council at the Parking Place.
- 16. The scale of charges for season tickets defined in Schedule 1B to this Order relating to Electric Vehicles shall only apply to zero emission Electric Vehicles.
