The Sandwell Borough Council (West Bromwich Town Centre Loading Areas) (Prohibition of Parking) Order, 1990

The Borough Council of Sandwell (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") under Section 61 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended by Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act, 1985, (hereinafter called "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police and with the consent of the owner and occupiers of the loading areas mentioned below, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as The Sandwell Borough Council (West Bromwich Town Centre Loading Areas) (Prohibition of Parking) Order, 1990 and shall come into operation on 23rde July 1990.
- 2. In this Order -

"authorised vehicle" means a goods vehicle (as defined in Section 196(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972) which is in on of the loading areas for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with a trade or business specified in Article 4(ii) below

"the loading areas" means the areas of land designated by Article 4(i) below

3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

- been set apart by the occupiers thereof for use as places
 where vehicles may be driven and parked for the purpose of
 being loaded or unloaded in connection with a trade or
 business specified in paragraph (ii) below are hereby
 designated as areas to which the provisions of sub-sections

 (2) to (8) of Section 61 of the Act of 1984 apply
 - (ii) The trades or businesses carried on from the retail premises within the curtilage of the West Bromwich Town Centre are trades or businesses which are carried on on or in the vicinity of the land mentioned in paragraph (i) above and are trades or businesses in connection with which vehicles may be driven and parked on that land for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded
- 5. Subject to Article 6 below the parking of vehicles in the loading areas at any time in any week is prohibited
- 6. Nothing in Article 5 above shall affect the parking of:-
 - (i) any authorised vehicle while it is being loaded or unloaded
 - (ii) any vehicle the presence of which in the loading areas is required for police ambulance or fire brigade purposes
 - (iii) any vehicle the presence of which in the loading areas is occasioned by reason of the carrying out of building or maintenance operations affecting premises adjoining or adjacent to the loading areas or of maintenance work on the loading areas themselves

- (iv) any vehicle the presence of which in the loading areas is specifically authorised in writing by the Council
- (v) any vehicle belonging to a statutory undertaker or the operator of a telecommunications code system under the Telecommunications Act, 1984 where the presence of that vehicle in the loading areas is required to enable the functions of such undertaker or operator to be carried out
- (vi) any refuse disposal vehicle engaged in the collection of refuse
- 7. Nothing in Article 5 above shall prohibit the parking of any vehicle belonging to a Market Trader on those areas of land coloured yellow on the drawing numbered 14811 S/2 and annexed to this Order (hereinafter called "the drawing") provided that this exemption shall only apply on days when a Market is being held in West Bromwich Town Centre.

- All those areas of land forming part of the services areas to West Bromwich Town Centre and shown coloured yellow on the drawing.
