THE BOROUGH OF SCARBOROUGH (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING) ORDER 2013

North Yorkshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1) and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on 15 April 2013 and shall be cited as "The Borough of Scarborough (Prohibiton of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Order 2013".
- 2 This Order hereby amends the following Traffic Regulation Order:-
 - "The Borough of Scarborough (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Consolidation Order 2011".
- 3 By this Order Article 21 of the Traffic Regulation Order specified in Article 2 of this Order shall be modified to read as follows:-
 - "Save as provided in Article 5 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil enforcement officer, cause any vehicle to wait in any parking place during the times specified for that parking place in Schedule 2 to this Order unless it is displaying in the relevant position a permit valid for that parking place at that time or, being a Disc Parking Place, is displaying a parking disc as specified in Article 19. The types of permit, parking places, entitlement and permit charges are described in Schedule 4 to this Order".
- By this Order Schedule 2 of the Traffic Regulation Order specified in Article 2 of this Order shall be modified as follows:-
 - The informative lines within the schedule stating in which Residents' parking zone each street within the Controlled Parking Zone is located are to be removed to ease confusion with information displayed in the 'zone' column of Schedule 2.
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
