THE SEDGEMOOR DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2013 (AMENDMENT No. 5) ORDER 2022 Minor Order

The Sedgemoor District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in accordance with Regulation 21(1)(b) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act of 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Somerset County Council ("the County Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 32, 33 & 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986) and Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and the provisions of Part 6 of The Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 September 2022 and may be cited as "The Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 (Amendment No. 5) Order 2022" hereinafter referred to as "this Order".
- 2. As part of the development of the Northgate Leisure Complex the provisions of The Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall be amended by the introduction of pay and display parking at Blake Car Park Bridgwater in addition to permit parking and in order to avoid confusion the renaming of Northgate car park to West Quay car park and the updating of the order for cashless payment
- 3. The provisions of The Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall be amended by inserting in Schedule 1 at Blake Car Park the following schedule;

- 4. The provisions of The Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall be amended by deleting from Schedule 1 item 8 reference to Northgate car park Bridgwater and replacing it with West Quay car park Bridgwater and from Schedule 2 (plans of car parks) at item 9 replacing Northgate car park with West Quay car park
- 5. In order to facilitate cashless payment the provisions of The Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall be amended by deleting paragraph 12 and replacing it with the following:
- 12. In so far as a motor vehicle is parked in a car park during the charging hours specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, the driver thereof shall purchase a parking ticket, paying such charge or charges as are specified in Schedule 2 of this Order and on the relevant car park notice. Provided that no charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle left in a parking place, the driver of which displays a valid season ticket, permit or disabled persons badge
- 12.1 Payment of the Parking Charge referred to in Article 12 shall be made in every case in accordance with:
- (a) the conditions and instructions displayed in the Parking Place by an Approved Method of Payment and using any Parking Device provided by the Council at the Parking Place for payment of the Parking Charge in the Parking Place being (for example but without limitation) by means of:
- (b) The purchase of a Pay and Display Ticket from the Ticket Machine; or
- (c) By paying a parking Civil Enforcement Officer;
- (d) Through any electronic cashless payment facility provided by or on behalf of the Council either through a Parking Device located within the Parking Place
- (e) remotely using the Driver's own computer, device, smart phone, debit or credit card or prepaid card system
- 12.2 The expiry of the period for which the charge has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing pay and display ticket machine is later than the time exhibited on the pay and display ticket displayed on the vehicle. Where payment has been made by mobile telephone payment evidence shall be provided by the mobile telephone payment provider

12.3 Where the parking fee has been paid to the council by credit, debit card or cashless payment facility the parking period shall commence on receipt by the Council of the all the details required and expire at the end of the period for which payment has been made.

- 6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 7. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
