(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2013

The Sedgemoor District Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under sections 32, 33 & 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all enabling powers and subsequent legislation and with the consent of the County Council of Somerset, in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 of the 1984 Act and the Area Traffic Commissioner under Part V of schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

PART 1 - GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

 This Order shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of July 2013 and may be cited as the Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 and shall revoke all previous Orders.

Revocations

2. The following Order is hereby revoked:-

The Sedgemoor District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1997

Interpretation

- Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- The headings in this Order are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect its construction or interpretation
- 5. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

"the Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

"the 2000 Regulations" means The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000 (as amended)

"the 2004 Act" means the Traffic Management Act 2004

"authorised officer" means a Civil Enforcement Officer or any person as defined by the relevant legislation duly authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise and enforce the operation of the car parks or any parts thereof "car park" means the area or areas of land, specified by name in Schedule 1 hereto and defined by the plans included in that schedule

"car park notice" means the notice that is displayed in each car park and describes the conditions contained in Schedule 1 of this Order under which a motor vehicle may be left in the car park

"causes" includes permits

"charging hours" means any period for which a charge is specified in Schedule 1

"controlled hours" means the hours during which enforcement may be carried out

"Council" means Sedgemoor District Council

"County Council" means Somerset County Council

"CEO" means a Civil Enforcement Officer or any person duly authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise and enforce the operation of the car park or any part thereof

"disabled persons badge" means a badge in the form prescribed by Regulation 11 of the 2000 Regulations issued by a local authority for display on a motor vehicle driven by a disabled person or used for the carriage of a disabled person and includes a replacement badge issued in accordance with Regulation 7 of those Regulations and is currently in force

"driver" means the registered keeper of the vehicle registered with the DVLA at the time the contravention was committed, unless it is proved to the Council's satisfaction that the vehicle at the time of the contravention was in the charge of a person other than the registered keeper

"motor vehicle, motor car, motor cycle, invalid carriage and trailer" have the same meaning as in the Road Traffic Act 1988

Motor caravan has the same meaning as in section 3 Motor Vehicles (Test) Regulations 1981

"owner" means the legally responsible person or organisation

"parking bay" means any area of a parking place made available for parking, as indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place

"parking place" means any place in the car park marked on the surface of the car park by lines or indicated by signs, which is provided for the parking of motor vehicles

"parking meter" means an apparatus designed to indicate the time and to issue numbered tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the day and time on which the charge was paid or expires

"parking ticket" means the ticket issued by means of the parking meter or via the Council showing the period of validity and to be displayed in the vehicle

"PCN" means Penalty Charge Notice

"permit" means a permit issued by the Council which entitles a vehicle to park in the car park specified on that permit without displaying a parking ticket and also entitles a vehicle to park in a car parking place designated for permit holders only

"reserved space" means the parking place in the car park that is marked on the surface and/or indicated by signs as being reserved

"season ticket" means the ticket issued by the Council indicating the vehicle registration mark(s) of the motor vehicle(s) on which it may be used, the car park(s) in which it may be used and the period of its validity in accordance with the Council's terms and conditions

"serve" in respect of a PCN means the forms of service specified in Regulations 9 & 10 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) general Regulations 2007 or any amendment or re-enactment thereof, including the service of PCN's by post or any amendment or re-enactment thereof

All other words and phrases, where the context permits, have the same meanings as in the Road Traffic Act 1988 or any amendment or re-enactment thereof

PART 2 - REGULATIONS

Use of land and parking places

- 6. Each of the areas specified by name in Schedule 1 may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles, in such manner and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area in Schedule 1. No person shall unless authorised in writing by the Council use any car park for any other purpose
- 7. Where in Schedule 1 to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or on specified days or during specified hours, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place:-
 - (a) Unless it is of the specified class
 - (b) On the days and hours other than those specified
- 8. A Driver shall not permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place:-
 - (a) If the total laden weight of the vehicle, including, in the case of an articulated vehicle, the weight of the trailer, exceeds 7.5 tonnes
 - (b) Which is marked with parking bays, except wholly within one of such bays
 - (c) Within a parking place marked as reserved for season ticket or permit holders, except where such vehicle displays a valid season ticket or permit

- (d) Within a parking place marked as reserved for disabled only, except where such a vehicle displays a valid disabled persons badge
- 9. With the exception of the Eastover Short Stay (Coach Station,) Mount Street South and Queen Street, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place for a period longer than 24 hours without the prior consent of the Council
- 10. If at any time in or adjoining a parking place there is displayed a notice to the effect that a particular bay is reserved for the leaving of a particular class of vehicle, no persons shall leave a vehicle in any such parking bay other than a vehicle of a class so specified
- 11. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, the Council may, by notice displayed on or near the parking place, close such parking place or part thereof for any period and no driver of any vehicle shall use such parking place or part thereof when it is so closed

Charges, Parking Meters & Purchase & Display of Tickets

- 12. In so far as a motor vehicle is parked in a car park during the charging hours specified in Schedule 1 of this Order, the driver thereof shall purchase a parking ticket, paying such charge or charges as are specified in Schedule 2 of this Order and on the relevant car park notice. Provided that no charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle left in a parking place, the driver of which displays a valid season ticket, permit or disabled persons badge
- 13. Any parking ticket issued on payment of the relevant charge shall be immediately displayed in a conspicuous position in the front of the vehicle in respect of which it was issued so that the time shown on the front of the said ticket is clearly visible from outside the vehicle
- 14. Any season ticket or permit issued by the Council shall be displayed to cover the whole period that the vehicle is parked in a conspicuous position in the front of the vehicle to which it was issued so that it is clearly visible from outside the vehicle
- 15. A parking ticket is only valid in the car park in which it was issued for the time period displayed on the ticket
- 16. Parking at the Eastover Short Stay (Coach Station) Bridgwater for coach passengers, shall be by way of parking ticket purchased from a ticket machine at the rate specified in Schedule 1 and displayed in a conspicuous position in the vehicle to which it was issued, together with details of the coach service the driver is using so that they are clearly visible from outside the vehicle. All other drivers shall park by way of a parking ticket purchased from a ticket machine in accordance with the rates specified in Schedule 1 and displayed in a conspicuous position in the vehicle to which it was issued so that it is clearly visible from outside
- 17. If at any time while a vehicle is left in a car park and no parking ticket is clearly displayed on that vehicle, it shall be deemed that the charge has not been paid and

will be subject to the penalty provisions within this Order, unless the vehicle is displaying one of the following:-

- (a) any other valid permit or season ticket that may be issued by the Council from time to time
- (b) valid Disabled Persons Badge
- 18. A parking ticket is not transferable from one vehicle to another

Penalty Charge for Use of Car Parks

- 19. If a motor vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of or non-compliance with this Order a penalty charge notice shall be payable by the driver of the motor vehicle
- 20. The penalty charge or reduced penalty charge where payment is received within 14 days shall be the amount prescribed in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges)(England) Order 2007 (as amended or superseded from time to time)
- 21. If no payment is made within 28 days of the serving of a PCN, the Council will issue a Notice to Owner advising of the unpaid charge
- 22. I no payment is made within 28 days of the serving of the Notice to Owner, the Council may issue a charge certificate in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 21 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (as amended or superseded from time to time) this will result in the penalty charge being increased by fifty percent
- 23. Service of a PCN, Notice to Owner or charge certificate by post is deemed effective on the second working day after the day of posting
- 24. Where a contravention of this Order has occurred an authorised officer may attach to the vehicle concerned in a conspicuous position or hand to the driver a PCN which shall comply with the requirements of regulation 9 and the Schedule to the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (as amended or superseded from time to time)
- 25. Where a penalty has been incurred a PCN may be issued by post by the authorised officer if the owner of the motor vehicle drives the motor vehicle away before the authorised officer has issued a PCN or the authorised officer has been prevented from issuing a PCN. Such a PCN shall comply with the requirements of Regulation 10 and the Schedule to the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (as amended or superseded from time to time)
- 26. Payment of the PCN shall be made in accordance with the directions specified on the back of the PCN. Payments may be made to Somerset County Council by cash, cheque postal order, credit or debit card

- 27. Payment of a PCN must be made by the date specified on the PCN but should the relevant office be closed on the relevant date specified the period for payment may be extended until the next working day
- 28. The particulars given in the PCN attached to the motor vehicle in accordance with this Order shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such penalty charge
- 29. In the event of the driver failing to pay a PCN within the period stipulated, the Council may give notice in writing to the owner of the motor vehicle in respect of which the penalty charge was incurred requiring the owner to supply the identity of the driver

Exemptions from Payment

30. Any motor vehicle left in a parking place that is displaying a disabled persons badge in the relevant position shall be exempt from payment of any charge specified in Schedule 1 to this Order. Any motor vehicle left in a parking place that is displaying a season ticket or permit shall be exempt from payment of any charge specified in Schedule 1 to this Order

Restrictions on Removal of Notice

31. When a notice or ticket has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the driver or a person authorised by the driver in that behalf, shall remove the notice or ticket from the vehicle

Other Restrictions

- 32. The driver of a vehicle shall not cause that vehicle to enter or remain in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988
- 33. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in a position in a parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place
- 34. No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services without the prior written consent of the Council
- **35.** No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place for the purposes of :
 - (a) Sleeping, camping or cooking; or

- (b) For the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place
- **36.** The Driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place
- 37. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 or 8 a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions
 - (2) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal
 - (3) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place, to remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place
 - (4) Any person altering or causing the alteration of the position of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph 1 of this Article, or removing or causing the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs 2 or 3 of this Article, may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed
 - (5) Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs 2 or 3 of this Article shall make such arrangements as he considers to be reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed
- 38. In respect of any vehicle removed under Article 38 hereof, if it appears to the Council that such vehicle has been abandoned, the Council shall sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle and any proceeds of the sale thereof shall be applied in or towards satisfaction of any costs incurred by the Council in connection with the removal, storage, sale or disposal thereof and where, following the sale or disposal of a vehicle and application of the proceeds in the manner described above, there remains outstanding any costs incurred by the Council in respect of the removal, storage or disposal of that vehicle, the Council shall be entitled to recover the same as a simple contract debt from the owner of the vehicle. Provided that the power of sale or disposal hereby conferred upon the Council shall not be exercised in the case of a vehicle unless there have been taken by the Council such steps and there has elapsed such period beginning with the taking of the first of them as are prescribed by the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986 as amended from time to time for securing adequate opportunity for the vehicle to be claimed

- **39. (1)** Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:
 - (a) Indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place; or
 - (b) Indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place;

No person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle:

- So that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated: or
- (ii) In a direction other than so specified
- (2) No person shall except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place
- (3) No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage for proceeding from one road to another road
- (4) In a parking place no person shall:
 - (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the prior written consent of the Council
 - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire
 - (c) no person shall in the parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or occupants of premises in the neighbourhood
 - (d) no person shall in the parking place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned
 - (e) no person shall in the parking place either encourage other persons to or themselves take part in any recreational activity

Exemptions

40. The driver of a motorcycle shall be exempt from any payment specified in this Order provide the motorcycle is parked within the specifically defined area of the car park reserved for the parking of motorcycles

Legal Proceedings

- 41. (1) For the purposes of the institution of proceedings in respect of any alleged contravention or non-compliance with the terms of this Order against any person as being the registered keeper of the vehicle at the relevant time; and
 - (2) In any proceedings in respect of the alleged contravention or non-compliance with the terms of this Order brought against any person as being the registered keeper of the vehicle at the relevant time it shall be presumed (notwithstanding that that person may not be an individual) that he was the driver of the vehicle at that time and accordingly the cats or omissions of the driver of the vehicle at that time were his acts or omissions.

Liabilities and Penalties

- 42. The Council will not accept any responsibility for injury loss or damage in any of the Council's parking places to which this Order applies unless caused by the negligence of the Council
- 43. Any person who interferes with a sign ticket parking meter pay station or barrier or who operates or with intent to defraud attempts to operate a parking meter pay station or barrier by the insertion of objects other than current coins of the appropriate denomination or a ticket or pass issued for the purpose may be guilty of an offence for which they may be prosecuted
