

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIOUS ROADS, SELBY DISTRICT)
ORDER 2013

North Yorkshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PART 1
GENERAL

1. (1) When used in this Order each of the following expressions has the meaning assigned to it below:-

"disabled person" means a person who holds a disabled persons' badge in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (No. 682) (and in particular Regulation 4 thereof) or any re-enactment thereto;

"disabled person's badge" means a badge issued in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended) (in particular Regulation 11 and the Schedule thereto) or under regulations having effect in Scotland and Wales under Section 212 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 as referred to currently by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 (No. 683) or any subsequent further re-enactments thereof;

"disabled person's parking bay" means any area of carriageway designated as a parking bay reserved for disabled persons' badge holders and which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.3, 1032 or 1033 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 2005) and references in the Schedule to this Order to "disabled bay" and "disabled parking" shall be construed accordingly;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle driven by a disabled person as defined in Regulation 4(2) of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (No. 682);

"goods" shall mean items of any description which cannot easily be carried by one person and do not include goods that are not pre-ordered, shopping, small fragile goods or cash or other valuable securities which are being collected or delivered from a bank/building society;

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description;

"loading bay" means any area of carriageway designated as a parking bay reserved for loading and unloading goods and which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.3 or 1032 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 2005) and references in the Schedule to this Order to "loading only" shall be construed accordingly;

"loading/unloading" means when a vehicle stops to load or unload bulky or heavy goods;

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136(4) of the Act and references in the Schedule to this Order to "motorbike" shall be construed accordingly;

"motor cycle parking bay" means any area of carriageway designated as a parking bay reserved for motor cycles and which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 2005) and references in the Schedule to this Order to "motorbike parking" shall be construed accordingly;

"parking bay" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order, including this Order, made or having effect as if made under the Act being an area designated as a parking place, comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with Diagram 1032 or 1033 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 2005) and references in the Schedule to this Order to "parking area" and "parking space" shall be construed accordingly;

"post office" and any reference to "post office vehicle" or "postal packets" shall be construed in the context of the Postal Services Act 2000 and the Postal Services Act 2000 (Consequential Modifications to Local Enactments No. 1) Order 2001 (SI No. 2001/648) and shall include therefore references to "universal service providers", as the context shall require;

"relevant position" means (in conformity with Regulation 12 of SI 2000 No. 682 referred to above):-

- (a) in relation to a disabled person's badge,
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is clearly legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;

"road" means the full width of the highway including the carriageway and footway;

"school entrance area" means part of the carriageway outside a school entrance where vehicles should not stop and which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1027.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 2005);

"taxi" means a vehicle licensed under-

- (i) Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847; or
- (ii) Section 6 of the Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869 or under any similar enactment;

"taxi rank" means an area of carriageway reserved for use by taxis waiting to pick up passengers and which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) Regulations 2005).

- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

- 2. For the purposes of this Order any reference to a length of road shall be construed as a reference to the length specified in the Schedule to this Order of the side or sides of road specified in respect of that length in relation to the road named in respect of that side or those sides in that Schedule.

PART 2
PROHIBITION RESTRICTION AND LIMITATION OF WAITING

3. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (2) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to "no waiting at any time" restrictions.
4. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (2) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm, Monday to Saturday, in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.
5. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (2) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 7.00 pm each day in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.
6. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (2) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm, Monday to Saturday, in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.
7. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00 and 6.00 pm. Monday to Friday, in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,
 - (a) for a longer period than thirty minutes, or
 - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,as being subject to those restrictions.
8. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00 and 6.00 pm. Monday to Saturday, in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,
 - (a) for a longer period than ninety minutes, or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,as being subject to those restrictions.
9. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00 and 6.00 pm. Monday to Saturday, in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,
 - (a) for a longer period than thirty minutes, or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,as being subject to those restrictions.

10. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,

- (a) for a longer period than one hour, or
- (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,

as being subject to those restrictions.

11. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 5.00 pm and 9.00 am each day in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,

- (a) for a longer period than twenty minutes, or
- (b) if a period of less than four hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,

as being subject to those restrictions.

12. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm each day in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,

- (a) for a longer period than twenty minutes, or
- (b) if a period of less than four hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,

as being subject to those restrictions.

13. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00 and 6.00 pm each day in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,

- (a) for a longer period than sixty minutes, or
- (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,

as being subject to those restrictions.

14. Save as provided in article 15(1) or (3) of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8.00 and 6.00 pm each day in any length of road specified as a parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,

- (a) for a longer period than forty-five minutes, or
- (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,

as being subject to those restrictions.

Exemptions

15. (1) Nothing in articles 3, 4, 5, and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to the restrictions specified in those articles for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle or
 - (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle or
 - (c) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following operations:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any length of road specified in the said Schedule; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, any length of road specified in the said Schedule of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (v) the delivery or collection of postal packets as defined in Section 125(1) of the Postal Services Act 2000 at or from premises fronting any length of road specified in the said Schedule.
 - (d) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority for the purpose of the performance of the statutory functions of such authority;
 - (e) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any length of road specified in the said Schedule;
 - (f) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to any length of road specified in the said Schedule for so long as is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for or in connection with the purposes of any wedding or funeral taking or to take place from or at any such premises;
 - (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge whilst such vehicle is being used by or for the convenience of a disabled person and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those articles for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day).
- (3) Nothing in articles 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge whilst such vehicle is being used by or for the convenience of a disabled person and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge

of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any length of road referred to in those articles.

PART 3

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT FOR DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLES

16. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a disabled person's vehicle, to wait at any time in any length of road specified as a disabled person's parking bay in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.
17. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a disabled person's vehicle, to wait between 9.00 and 5.00 pm each day in any length of road specified as a disabled person's parking bay in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.
18. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a disabled person's vehicle, to wait between 8.00 and 6.00 pm, Monday to Saturday, in any length of road specified as a disabled person's parking bay in the Schedule to this Order,
 - (a) for a longer period than thirty minutes, or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the same length of road,

as being subject to those restrictions.

PART 4

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING

19. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a goods vehicle for the purpose of loading and unloading goods, to wait at any time in any length of road specified as a loading bay in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.
20. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a goods vehicle for the purpose of loading and unloading goods, to wait between 4.00 pm and 10.00 am each day in any length of road specified as a loading bay in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to those restrictions.

PART 5

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT FOR TAXIS

21. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a taxi, to wait at any time in any length of road specified as a taxi rank in the Schedule to this Order.

PART 6

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT FOR MOTOR CYCLES

22. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle, other than a motor cycle, to wait at any time in any length of road specified as a motor cycle parking bay in the Schedule to this Order.

PART 7
STOPPING PROHIBITED OUTSIDE SCHOOL ENTRANCE

23. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to no waiting restrictions between 8.00 and 5.00 pm, Monday to Friday, such lengths of road being designated as school entrance areas.
24. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order as being subject to no waiting restrictions between 8.00 and 9.00 am and between 3.00 pm and 4.00 pm, Monday to Friday, such lengths of road being designated as school entrance areas.

Exemptions

25. Nothing in articles 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any length of road to which those articles apply if it is necessary to do so to enable:-
- (i) the vehicle to be used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or
 - (ii) the vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
 - (iii) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, wire or cable or any apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.

PART 7
REVOCATION OF EXISTING ORDERS

26. The following Traffic Regulation Orders are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order:-
- (i) The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Peckfield and Cawood County Road, Cawood) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1966. is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (ii) Statutory Instruments 1969 No. 444 Road Traffic The Trunk Road (High Street, Carlton) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (iii) The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Fulford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (iv) Statutory Instruments 1976 No. 345 Road Traffic The Trunk Road (High Street, Bridge Street and Commercial Street, Tadcaster) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (v) The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Dish Hill, Byram) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (vi) The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Various Streets, Tadcaster) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (vii) The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Prohibition of Waiting) (Various Roads, Dunnington) Order 1984 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
 - (viii) The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Prohibition of Waiting) (Church Street, Dunnington) Order 1986 is hereby revoked in its entirety;

- (ix) North Yorkshire County Council (Restriction of Waiting) (Church Street, Copmanthorpe) Order 1992 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
- (x) North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) (Various Roads, Heslington) Order 1995 is hereby revoked in its entirety;
- (xi) North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting) (Colton Lane End, Colton Near Tadcaster) Order 2002 is hereby revoked in its entirety; and
- (xii) North Yorkshire County Council (Limitation of Waiting) (A162 Brotherton (Ferrybridge Bypass)) Order 2009 is hereby revoked in its entirety.

Any other existing Traffic Regulation Order which imposes waiting restrictions on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to that length of road.

PART 8 **OPERATION OF THE ORDER**

- 27. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be enforceable by an Officer authorised by the County Council or by any person authorised by any Statute, Statutory Instrument or other legal entitlement whatsoever to enforce this Order, such authorisations to be in writing signed by the Assistant Chief Executive (Legal and Democratic Services) on behalf of the County Council
- 28. This Order shall come into operation on 1 May 2013 and may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) (Various Roads, Selby District) Order 2013".
