

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL
(BUS PRIORITY) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1991
(AMENDMENT NO. 26) ORDER 1999

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (as amended) shall have effect as though:-

a) In EXEMPTIONS there was included the following Article:-

6(4) Nothing in Article 3, Article 4 or Article 5 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle in Royal Mail livery using these parts of Castle Square or High Street described in Items 1C and 2 of Schedule 1 Part 1 of this Order if that vehicle is requiring access to Angel Street for the purpose of making collections from pillar boxes situated on that road, or for servicing Post Office Counters premises situated on that road.

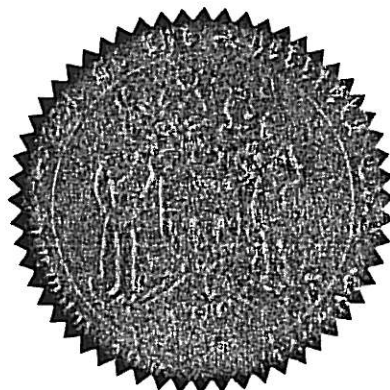
b) In EXEMPTIONS for Article 13A(n) there was substituted the following Article:-

13A(n) to proceed in that length of Angel Street described in item 1A(i) of Schedule 3 to this Order being a vehicle in Royal Mail livery, for the purpose of making collections from pillar boxes situated on that road or for servicing Post Office Counters premises situated on that road.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 8th day of November, 1999 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (Amendment No. 26) Order 1999.
