

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL  
(BUS PRIORITY) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1991  
(AMENDMENT NO.34) ORDER 2004

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (as amended) shall have effect as though:

a) There was included an Article 12B:-

12B Nothing in Article 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a any vehicle to enter or proceed in a south westerly direction on West Street from its junction with Leopold Street if that vehicle is doing so to gain access to the off-carriageway loading area between Leopold Street and Holly Street on the south east side of that road.

b) In Schedule 1 Part 1 thereto for the item '1E Eyre Street' there was substituted the following item:-

1E Eyre Street That area of carriageway of Eyre Street which extends from a point 85 metres north east of its junction with Cumberland Street to a point 68 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Matilda Street which is bounded:-  
a) on the north west side by the north western kerb line thereof;  
b) on the south east side by the authorised traffic sign.

AND

That area of carriageway of Eyre Street which extends from a point 75 metres north east of its junction with Jessop Street to its junction with St Mary's Gate which is bounded:-

a) on the south east/east side by the south eastern/eastern kerb line thereof;

b) on the north west/west side by the authorised traffic sign.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2004 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (Amendment No.34) Order 2004.
