
THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL (BUS PRIORITY) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1991 (AMENDMENT NO. 36) ORDER 2005



The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (as amended) shall have effect as though:
 - a) In Articles '6 (1) (ii)', '10 (2)(ii)', '12 (2) (a)' and '18' the words 'in an emergency' were deleted.
 - b) In Schedule 1 Part 1 thereto the item '12 Wicker' was revoked .
 - c) In Schedule 3 thereto there were included the following items:-

Description

1E Bridge Street

From its junction with Waingate for a distance

15 metres in a westerly direction.

6C Inner Relief Road

The right turn lane in the east bound carriageway at its junction with Gibralter

Street.

9E Nursery Street

That length of the offside north west bound lane in Nursery Street which extends from the north western kerb line of Spitalfields for a distance of 45 metres in a north westerly

direction.

14A Wicker

- (i) That length of the offside south west bound lane from its junction with the north eastern kerb line of the Inner Relief Road for a distance of 65 metres in a north easterly direction.
- (ii) That length of the south west bound lane from its junction with the south western kerb line of the Inner Relief Road for a distance of 35 metres in a south westerly direction.
- (iii) That length of the north east bound lane from a point 9 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Stanley Street to its junction with the south western kerb line of Scholey Street.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 22nd day of August, 2005 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (Amendment No. 36) Order 2005.
