The City of Sheffield (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1979

The Sheffield Metropolitan District Council in exercise of their powers under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") as amended and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf having obtained the consent of the South Yorkshire County Council in accordance with Section 28A of the Act of 1967 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

PART I

GENERAL

Commencement Citation and Revocation

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Sheffield" (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on the 17th day of September, 1979 on which date the City of Sheffield (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1967 shall be hereby revoked.

Interpretation

2.(1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"Council" means the Council of the Sheffield Metropolitan District
"Driver" in relation to a vehicle parking in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place

"Owner" has the same meaning as in Section 104(1) of the Act of 1967

"Parking bay" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the parking of a vehicle

"Parking Place" means that area of land specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order provided by the Council under Section 28(1) of the Act of 1967 for use as a parking place

"Relevant Position" means in relation to article 23 of this Order (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with its obverse side facing forwards on the nearside and immediately behind the windscreen or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

(2) The Interpretation Act 1973 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

PART II

USE OF PARKING PLACE

Use of Area as Parking Place

3. Each area of land specified by name in Column (1) of the Schedule to this Order may be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for the class of vehicle specified in Column (3) of the Schedule to this Order in such positions and on such days during such hours and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to that area in the said Schedule

Class and Position of Vehicle

4. Where in the Schedule to this Order the parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to park in that parking place unless it is:-

(a) of the specified class, on

Amount of Charge at Parking Place

5. The charge for a vehicle left in a parking place for any period during the charging hours shall be £2.00 per day. This charge is referred to, hereinafter, as the standard charge.

6. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which the standard charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a parking attendant employed by the Council to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:-

- (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
- (b) the time at which the parking attendant notices that the standard charge had been incurred;
- (c) a statement that the standard charge of £2.00 is required to be paid;
- (d) the manner in which and the time within which, the standard charge should be paid; and
- (e) a statement that it is an offence under this Order and Section 31(3) of the Act of 1967 for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to fail duly to pay the standard charge.

7. Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 6 of this Order, no person not being a parking attendant or some other person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the notice from the vehicle until the vehicle is removed from the parking place.

Manner of Payment of Excess Charge

8. The driver of a vehicle in respect of which the standard charge has been incurred shall pay such charge to the Council either by cheque, bankers draft, money order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the City Treasurer's Department of the Council at the Town Hall, Sheffield not later than 4.30 p.m. on the seventh day following the day on which the excess charge was incurred or in cash in person at the said Department not later than as aforesaid. Provided that if the said seventh day falls upon a day upon which the said Department is closed the period within which payment of the said charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 4.30 p.m. on the next full day on which the said Department is open.

9. (1) The driver of a vehicle left in any of the parking bays in the parking places referred to in Column (1) of the Schedule to this Order for a period not in excess of that allowed for the said parking place in Column (6) of such Schedule shall in respect of that period be exempt from payment of the standard charge provided that the driver has on leaving the vehicle in the parking bay paid the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column (7) of such Schedule.

(2) The charges referred to in the last preceding paragraph and specified in Column (7) of the Schedule to this Order shall be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the apparatus or device provided being an apparatus or device known as the Autoslot 7/5 manufactured by Control Systems Limited, such apparatus or device having been generally or specially approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment for such purposes.

(3) Any ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in Paragraph

(1) of this Article will indicate either payment of the charge and the date of issue or the date and time of issue and the period running from that time during which parking is permitted and such ticket shall be attached to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued:-

(a) in the case of a motor cycle combination in a conspicuous position on the vehicle in front of the driving seat and
(b) in the case of all other vehicles:-

(i) where the vehicle is fitted with a transparent windscreen facing forwards on the inside surface of the windscreen so that it can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle

(ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a transparent windscreen on the nearside of the vehicle in a conspicuous position

(4) If at the time when a vehicle is left in a parking place to which this Article applies there is no ticket machine at the parking place or all the ticket machines at that parking place carry notices placed upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council, indicating that they are out of order, the driver of that vehicle shall be exempt from payment of the appropriate charge.

Miscellaneous Provisions

10. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

11. No person shall use the vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.

12. The driver of a vehicle drawing a trailer shall not permit the vehicle or trailer to wait in a parking place unless they have been disconnected and for the purpose of this Order the vehicle and the trailer shall be deemed to be separate vehicles and the driver of the leading vehicle shall be deemed to be the driver of both of the vehicles.

13. Subject to the proviso hereto when a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of Article 4 Article 5(1) or (2) or Article 13 of this Order the person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place. Provided that when a vehicle is parking in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 4(b) of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.

14. The driver of the vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to park in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1962 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1972.

15. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from that parking place.

16. No person shall except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council drive any vehicle in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in that parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from that parking place.

17. No person shall in the parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of a parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.

18. No person shall in a parking place use any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.

19. No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place:-

- (a) for sleeping or camping purposes
- (b) for eating or cooking purposes or
- (c) for the purpose of servicing washing painting or otherwise tending any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from that parking place

20. No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage for a vehicle proceeding from one road to another road.

21. Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-

- (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place or
- (b) indicating that a vehicle using that parking place shall proceed in the specified direction within the parking place no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven in any vehicle (1) so that it enters that parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves that parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated or (2) in a direction other than that specified as the case may be.

22. In a parking place no person shall:-

- (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent booth stand building or other structure without the written consent of the Council
- (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.

23. The following vehicles left in a parking place shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from payment of any charge specified in Column (7) of the Schedule to this Order

- (1) An invalid carriage
- (2) A vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Department of Health and Social Security in lieu of an invalid carriage
- (3) A disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 or a badge having effect under those regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge
- (4) A motor cycle without a sidecar
- (5) A pedal cycle

24. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order the Council may by notice displayed on or near a parking place or parking bay (i) close that parking place or bay or part thereof for any period or (ii) specify that only such classes of vehicles as may be specified in the notice may park there and no driver of any vehicle shall use the parking place or bay or part thereof in contravention of the terms of the notice.

Indications by Ticket Issuing Machines and Tickets as Evidence

25. If during charging hours a vehicle is left in a parking place and has displayed on it a ticket or tickets issued by a ticket issuing

machine the time indicated on the ticket issuing machine clock shall be evidence as to whether the period has expired for which the initial charge shown on such ticket or tickets was paid and in any proceedings for an offence under Section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 of failing to pay the excess charge shall also be evidence that an excess charge was incurred.

Duty to Give Information as to Identity of Driver

26. (1) Where the driver of a vehicle is alleged to be guilty of an offence to which this Order applies the owner of the vehicle shall give such information as to the identity of the driver as he may be required to give by or on behalf of the Council and

(2) Any other person shall if required as aforesaid give any information it is in his power to give which may lead to the identification of the driver.

Incorporation of Section 42 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967

27. Subsections (5) (6) and (7) of Section 42 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 shall apply to a parking place provided under this Order and any offence committed under the provisions of Section 31 of the Act of 1967 as if it were a parking place provided on a highway

PART III

REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES


Removing or Altering the Position of a Vehicle

28. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 12 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be and the Council may recover any costs so incurred as a civil debt.

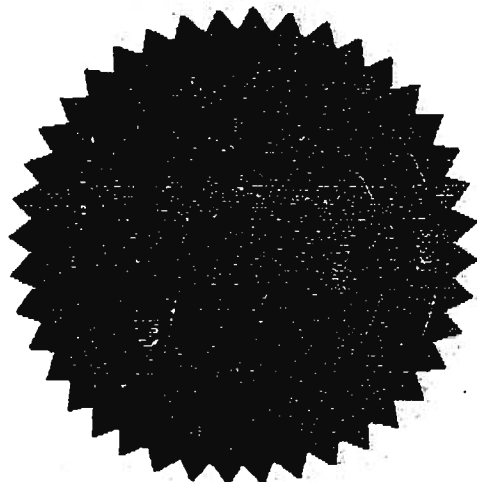
29. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 12 of this Order he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

30. A parking attendant or any other person duly authorised by the Council may move or cause to be moved in case of emergency to any place he thinks fit vehicles left in a parking place.



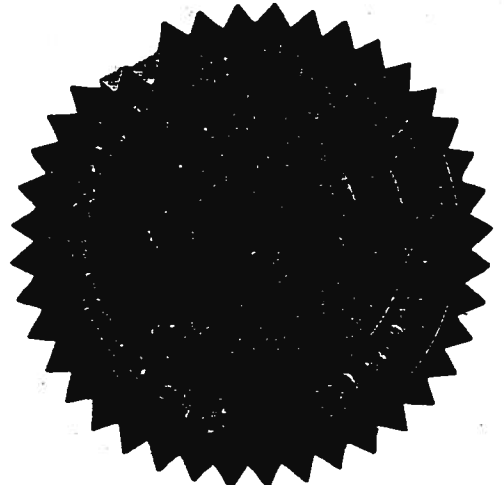

- (iv) the substitution of the words "Article 9(1)(2) or (3)" for "Article 5(1) or (2)" appearing in Article 13.
- (v) the substitution of the words "Article 12" for the words "Article 13" appearing in Article 13.
- (vi) the addition of the words "Article 11" after the words "Article 9(1)(2) or (3)" and before the words "or Article 12" appearing in Article 13.

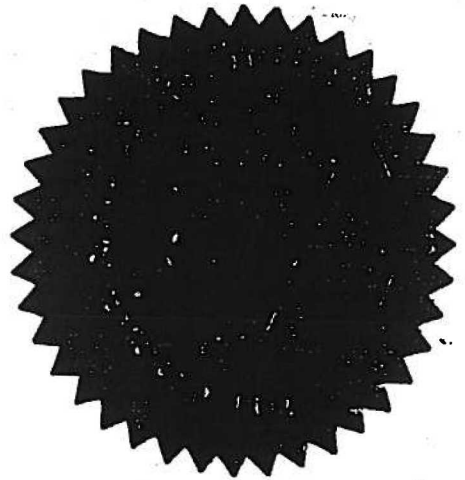

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of their powers under Section 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The City of Sheffield (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1979 (as varied) shall have effect as though for Articles 5, 6 and 8 there was substituted the following Articles:-

Amount of charge at parking place

5. The charge for a vehicle left in a parking place for any period during the charging hours shall be £25 per day. This charge is referred to, hereinafter, as the standard charge.
6. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which the standard charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a parking attendant employed by the Council to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:-
 - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
 - (b) the time at which the parking attendant notices that the standard charge has been incurred;
 - (c) a statement that the standard charge of £25 is required to be paid;
 - (d) the manner in which and the time within which the standard charge should be paid; and
 - (e) a statement that it is an offence under this Order and Section 35(4) and (5) of the Act of 1984 for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to fail duly to pay the standard charge.

Manner and times of payment of standard charge

8. The driver of a vehicle in respect of which the standard charge has been incurred shall pay such charge to the Council either by cheque, bankers draft, money order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the City Treasurer's Department of the Council at the Town Hall, Norfolk Street, not later than 4.30 p.m. on the fourteenth day following the day on which the standard charge was

incurred or in cash in person or by messenger at the said City Treasury not later than aforesaid:


Provided that if the sum of £10 is paid to the Council in the manner aforesaid not later than 4.30 p.m. on the seventh day following the day on which the excess charge was incurred the payment of such sum shall be treated as being payment of the whole of the standard charge:

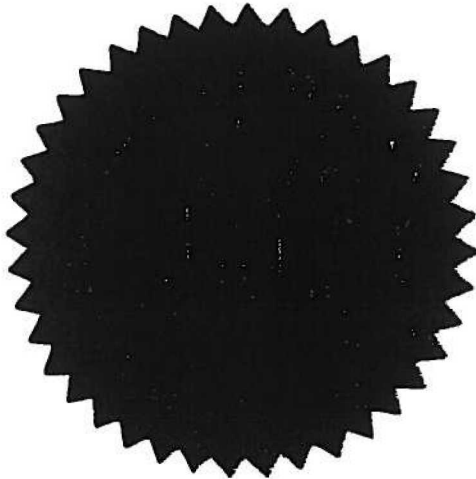
