# THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL (PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1987

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

## Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 26th day of December 1987, and may be cited as "The Sheffield City Council (Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 1987.

#### Interpretation

#### (1) In this Order

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 1975;

"disabled person's vehicles" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975;

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle not exceeding 30 cwt unloaden weight for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, and is not drawing a trailer;

"motor car", "motor cycle" and "invalid carriage" have the same me respectively as in Section 136 of the Act;

"one-way street" means a highway in which the driving of vehicles otherwise than in one direction is prohibited at all times;

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place.

"parking bay" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631:1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

"parking meter" means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Minister for the purpose of this Order being apparatus designed to indicate:-

- (a) whether the initial charge referred to in Article 7 of this Order has been paid and whether the initial period for which it has been paid has elapsed;
- (b) whether the period referred to in Article 10 of this Order (being the period for which a vehicle may remain in a parking place after the excess charge has been incurred) has elapsed;

"parking place" means an area on a highway designated as parking place by Article 3 of this Order;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or an invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry no more than twelve passengers exclusie of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;

"permitted hours" means the period between 8 a.m., and 6.30 p.m., on any day not being a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday;

"telegraphic line" has the same meaning as in the Telegraphic Act 1878;

"traffic warden" means a traffic warden employed by a police authority in pursuance of Section 95 of the Act.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
  - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -
    - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; and
    - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle; and
  - (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- (4) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule being that number in this Order.

#### Designation of Parking Places

3. Each area on a highway in the City of Sheffield which is described as a designated parking place in the Schedule to this Order is designated as a parking place.

## Number and Situation of Parking Bays

4. The number of parking bays in each parking place shall not exceed the number specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order in relation to that parking place, and the number and situation of such parking bays in each parking place shall be as may be determined by the Council:

Provided that where a figure is specified in column 4 of the Schedule to this Order in relation to any area of carriageway described in column 2 of the said Schedule there shall at all times be a part or parts of the said area of a total length in metres not less than that figure and of a width equal to the width of the said area in which there shall be no parking bay or part of a parking bay.

#### Marking on the Carriageway of Parking Places and Parking Bays

5. The limits of each parking place and the limits of any parking hays in a parking place shall be indicated on the carriageway in such manner as the Council may determine by lines, study or other indications.

## Vehicles for which Parking Places are Designated

6. Each parking place may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles as are passenger vehicles, goods vehicles, motor cycles or invalid carriages.

# Amount of Initial Charges at Parking Places

- 7. (1) The initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order during the permitted hours shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be either:-
  - (a) forty pence for an initial period of not more than one hour; or
  - (b) twenty pence for an initial period of not more than the sum of thirty minutes and the unexpired time (if any) so, however, that such period of time shall not exceed one hour;
  - (2) The initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place described in Part II of the Schedule to this Order during the permitted hours shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be either:-
    - (a) forty pence for an initial period of not more than two hours; or
    - (b) twenty pence for an initial period of not more than the sum of one hour and the unexpired time (if any) so, however, that such period of time shall not exceed two hours.
  - (3) For the purpose of this Article the expression "unexpired time" means, in relation to the parking meter in which is inserted any coin for the purpose of payment of the initial charge, any period for which a previous initial charge was paid and which is shown as unexpired on the time scale mentioned in paragrah (1) of Article 14 to this Order immediately prior to the insertion of that coin.

# Method of Payment of Initial Charge

8. The initial charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in a parking place described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule to this Order by the insertion in the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left of a coin of the denomination of twenty pence or if the initial charge is forty pence by the insertion in the meter immediately one after the other of two coins each of the denomination of twenty pence.

### Amount of Excess Charge at Parking Places

- 9. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours for longer than the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge, the initial charge together with an additional amount of £10.00 pounds (which additional amount is hereinafter referred to as the "excess charge") shall be payable.
  - (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which an excess charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a traffic warden or parking attendant to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:-
    - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
    - (b) the time at which he first noticed that the parking meter indicated in the manner specified in paragraph (2) of Article 14 of this Order that the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge had expired;
    - (c) a statement that an excess charge of £10.00 is required to be paid;
    - (d) the manner in which, and the time within which, the excess charge should be paid; and
    - (e) a statement that it is an offence under Section 47 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to fail duly to pay the excess charge.

#### Period for which Vehicle may be left after excess Charge incurred

10. The period for which a vehicle may be left in a parking place during the permitted hours after the excess charge has been incurred shall not exceed two hours.

## Restriction on removal of Notices

11. Where a notice has been attached to vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (2) of Article 9 of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, or a police constable in uniform, or a traffic warden or a parking attendant shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

## Manner and times of payment of excess charge

12. The excess charge shall be paid to the Council either by cheque, bankers draft, money order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the City Treasury of the Council at the Town Hall, Norfolk Street, not later than 4.30 p.m. on the fourteenth day following the day on which the excess charge was incurred or in cash in person or by messenger at the said City Treasury not later than aforesaid:

Provided that, if the sum of Six pounds is paid to the Council in the manner aforesaid not later than 4.30 p.m. on the seventh day following the day on which the excess charge was incurred the payment of such sum shall be treated as being payment of the whole of the excess charge;

Provided further that, if the seventh day or the fourteenth day, whichever is the case, falls upon a day on which the City Treasury is closed, the period within which payment of the said charge or reduced sum shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 4.30 p.m. on the next full day on which the said City Treasury is open.

#### Parking Meters to be installed at Parking Places

13. There shall be a parking meter on or in the vicinity of each parking bay in a parking place.

#### Indications by Parking Meters

- 14. (1) Payment of the initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by a pointer showing on a time scale on the parking meter a period equal to the initial period for which payment was made by any such initial charges as is specified in Article 7 of this Order and thereafter until that period has elapsed how much of it at any time remains unexpired.
  - (2) The expiry of the initial period for which the initial charge has been paid shall be indicated by the appearance on the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left of a yellow flag displaying the words "excess charge".
  - (3) The expiry of the period mentioned in Article 10 of this Order (being the period for which a vehicle may remain in a parking place after the excess charge has been incurred) shall be indicated by the appearance on the parking meter of a red flag displaying the word "penalty".

# Parking Meter Indications as Evidence

- 15. (1) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left gives the indication mentioned in paragraph (2) of the last preceding Article, it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the initial charge has been duly paid or is treated under paragraph (1) or (2) of Article 26 of this Order as having been paid in respect of that vehicle and that the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge has already expired.
  - (2) Where a parking meter relating to a parking bay in which a vehicle is left gives the indication mentioned in paragraph (3) of the last preceding Article, that indication shall
    - (a) in any proceedings for an offence under paragraph (a) of Section 47(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 of leaving the vehicle in the parking place for longer after the excess charge has been incurred that the time authorised by Article 10 of this Order, be evidence that it was so left; and
    - (b) in any proceedings for an offence under the said paragraph (a) of failing duly to pay the excess charge, be evidence that that charge was incurred.

## No additional coins to be inserted after payment of initial charge

16. No person shall insert in a parking meter relating to the parking bay in which a vehicle is left any coins additional to those inserted by way of payment of the initial charge in respect of that vehicle.

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## Interval before vehicle again to be left

17. No vehicle which has been taken away from a parking bay in a parking place, after the initial charge has been incurred, shall until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken away again be left in that parking place during the permitted hours.

### Manner of standing in parking places

- 18. Every vehicle left in a parking place in respect of which a charge has been incurred shall so stand -
  - (a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of vehicles in that place are specified in column 5 of the Schedule to this Order, in accordance with those provisions:
  - (b) in the case of any other parking place -
    - if the parking place is not in a one-way street, that the left or near side of the vehicle is adjacent to the lefthand edge of the carriageway;
    - (ii) if the parking place is in a one-way street, that the left or near side of the vehicle is adjacent to the right-hand edge of the carriageway or that the right or offside of the vehicle is adjacent to the right-hand edge of the carriageway; and
    - (iii) that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than twelve inches; and
  - (c) that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay which shall be the appropriate bay in relation to the parking meter in which a coin or coins for the amount of the initial charge has or have been or should have been inserted.

# Alteration of position of vehicle in parking places

19. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of the last preceding Article or of the provisions of paragraph (4) of Article 26 of this Order, a traffic warden may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

## Removal of vehicle for parking places

20. Where a traffic warden is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Article 8, Article 10, Article 16 or Article 17 of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

#### Movement of vehicles in parking places in emergencies

21. Any person duly authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden may move or cause to be moved, in case of emergency to any place he thinks fit, vehicles left in a parking place.

# Power to suspend use of parking places

- 22. (1) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary
  - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
  - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line, traffic sign or parking meter;
  - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
  - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
  - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
  - (2) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than twentyfour hours the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
  - (3) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) or paragraph (2) of this Article shall thereupon:-
    - (a) place or cause to be placed over the parking meters relating to the parking bays which are within that parking place or that part thereof hoods or other covers indicating that the use of the bays is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited, and
    - (b) place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that parking place which is not a parking bay and the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

- (4) On any suspension of the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article, any person duly authorised by the Council may temporarily remove any parking meter relating to any parking bay within that parking place or, as the case may be, that part thereof and any post, bracket or other support on which that parking meter is fitted and shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking bay a traffic sign giving the indication referred to in pararaph (3)(b) of this Article.
- (5) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left -

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- (a) in a parking bay during such period as there is over the parking meter relating to that bay a hood or other cover indicating that the use of the bay is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent to that bay a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (4) of this Article;
- (b) in any part of a parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (3)(b) of this Article;

Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to be left in the parking bay during either such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (a) or in the part of a parking place, not being a parking bay, during such period as is referred to in sub-paragraph (b), if the vehicle is left within the permission (i) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or the part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (l) of this Article, (ii) of a police constable in uniform or (iii) of a traffic warden.

## Restriction of use of vehicles at parking places

No person shall use any vehicle, while it is in a parking place during the permitted hours, in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of his skill in handicraft or his services in any other capacity:

Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle:-

- (a) if the vehicle is one which may be left in a parking place in accordance with Article 6 of this Order and the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected; or
- (b) if the vehicle is one to which the provisions of (viii) of subparagraphh (a) in or of sub-paragraph (b) in paragraph (l) of Article 24 of this Order apply.

# Restriction of Waiting of Vehicles in Parking Places

24. (1) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order with respect to vehicles which are left in a parking place in accordance with those provisions, any other vehicle may wait during the permitted hours -

- (a) anywhere in a parking place if -
  - (i) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (ii) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident;
  - (iii) the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance, or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or a vehicle in the service of a police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (iv) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (v) the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Postmaster General and is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle, or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting, or is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks adjacent to the parking place;
  - (vi) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by British Telecom and is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks adjacent to that road;
  - (vii) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (l) of Article 22 of this Order;
  - (viii) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises for a depository; or
    - (xi) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise, including, so far as a Bank is concerned, cash or other valuables or valuable securities, or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for such purpose for more than thirty minutes or for such longer period as a police constable in uniform may authorise; and
- (b) anywhere in a parking place other than in a parking bay if goods are sold from the vehicle by a person who is licensed by the Council to sell goods from a stationary pitch situated in the parking place.

- (2) No charge specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article.
- (3) Except as provided in the foregoing provisions of this Article, the driver of a vehicle shall not cause or permit the vehicle to wait in a parking place during the permitted hours.
- (4) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Article shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any regulation made or having effect as if made under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984

# Manner of Waiting in Parking Places

- A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking place by virtue of the provisons of (v), (vi), (vii) or (viii) of sub-paragraph (a) in or of sub-paragraph (b) in paragraph (l) of the last preceding Article shall take all such steps as are necessary to ensure
  - (a) In the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of vehicles in that place are specified in column 5 of the Schedule to this Order that the vehicle shall so stand -
    - (i) unless the length of the vehicle precludes compliance with this sub-paragraph, in accordance with those provisions and so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place; or
    - (ii) if the length of the vehicle does preclude compliance with the last preceding sub-paragraph that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriage way nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than twelve inches; and
  - (b) In the case of any other parking place, that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than twelve inches.

## Exemptions from Charges

- 26. (1) A vehicle left during the permitted hours in a parking bay vacated by another vehicle after payment of the initial charge in respect of that other vehicle and so left before the expiration of the period for which the charge was paid shall be exempt from payment of the initial charge, if payment of that charge is not made in accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of this Order on the leaving of the vehicle; and any vehicle so exempted shall be treated as if it had been left, and the initial charge paid in respect of it, at the time when that other vehicle was left and all the provisions of this Order shall apply
  - (2) If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a parking bay there is on the parking meter relating to that bay a notice placed by a person duly authorised by the Council, or a traffic warden,

indicating that the meter is out of order, that vehicle shall be exempt from the initial charge provided that it is removed in the case of a parking place described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order within one hour and in the case of a parking place described in Part II of the said Schedule within two hours after the said meter is rectified; if it be not removed within the period appropriate to that parking place the initial charge payable in respect of that period shall be treated as having been incurred and paid at the time when the vehicle was left in the parking bay by the insertion of a coin or coins for the amount of the initial charge in the parking meter and all the provisions of this Order shall apply accordingly.

- (3) A disabled person's vehicle, which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) left in parking bays during the permitted hours shall be exempt from the payment of any charge or compliance with any limitation of time during which a vehicle may be left in a parking place specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order.
- (4) Without prejudice to the generality of paragraph (1) or (2) of this Article, a vehicle to which paragraph (1), paragraph (2) or paragraph (3) of this Article applies shall stand in the parking bay in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of Article 18 of this Order and wholly within the limits of that bay.

### Installation of parking meters, etc.

## 27. The Council may -

- (a) install in such positions on or in the vicinity of a parking place as they may think fit such parking meters as are required by this Order for the purposes of that parking place; and
- (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasoably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

### Power to Dispose of Abandoned Vehicles

- 28. (1) The Council may as respects a vehicle which has been removed from a parking place in pursuance of Article 20 of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable inquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle.
  - (2) The Council shall be deemed not to have made reasonable inquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of any vehicle to which this Article applies unless they have taken in relation to that vehicle such steps as may be prescribed by any regulations for the time being in force under Sections 99 abd 101 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for authorising the Council to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle if it had been left on a road and if it appeared to the Council that it had been abandoned.

## General

- 29. The Orders specified in Schedule 2 to this Order are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to any of the lengths of road referred to in this Order.
- 30. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Act 1984 (as amended) or by or under any other enactment.





The Shoffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of February, 1992 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 1907 (Amendment No. ) Order 1992.
- 2. The Sheffield City Council (Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 1987 (as awended) (hereinatter referred to as the 1987 Order) shall have effect as though:-
  - (i) In the interpretation Section 2(1) there were included the following definitions:-

"ticker" means a ticket issued by a ticket issuing machine relating to any parking bay;

"ticket issuing anohine" means an apparatus designed to indicate the time externally, and to issue numbered tickets indicating the payment of a charge, the expiry of the period in respect of which the charge has been paid, the day and time at which the charge was paid, and incorporating the identification mark of the machine from which the ticket has been issued;

'tioner issuing machine relating to a parking bay" means a tioner issuing machine situated within reasonable walking sixtance of the parking bay.

- (II) For Article 7(5) of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-
  - For the purpose of this Article the expression "unexpired time" is appropriate to parking beys controlled by parking meters and means, in relation to the parking meter in which is inserted any coin(s) for the purpose of payment of the initial charge, any period for which a previous initial charge was paid and which is shown as unexpired on the time scale or digital display mentioned in paragraph 1(a) of Article 14 to this Order, immediately prior to the insertion of that coin or those coins.
- Clill For Article 8 of the 1987 Order relating to "Method of Payment of Initial Charge" there was substituted the following Article:-
  - 3(1). For a parting place controlled by parking meters the initial charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in:-

- (a) a parking place described in Parts I, II, III and V of the Schedule to this Order by the insertion in the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left of a coin of the denomination of twenty pence or if the initial charge is either forty pence or sixty pence or eighty pence by the insertion in the meter immediately one after the other of either two, three or four coins each of the denomination of twenty pence, or
- (b) a parking place described in Part IV of the Schedule to this Order by the insertion in the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left of a coin of the denomination of one pound, or if the initial charge is two pounds by the insertion in the meter immediately one after the other of two coins each of the denomination of one pound.
- For a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine the initial charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in the parking place by the insertion in a ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place of any coin or combination of coins together making up the amount of the initial charge and when more than one coin is required for payment of that charge the coins shall be inserted one immediately after the other in the ticket issuing machine.
- Upon payment of the initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a timet issuing machine the criver thereof shall display or cause to be displayed on the vehicle. In accordance with the provisions of the next following paragraph, the ticket issued by the ticket issuing machine on payment of the charge in accordance with the last preceding paragraph.
- The ticket referred to in the last preceding paragraph shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is left during the permitted hours in the parking place on the front or near side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on that side of the ticket which bears the indication that a charge has been paid are readily visible from the front or near side of the vehicle.
- (IV) For Article 9(2)(b) of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-
  - O(2) (b) The time at which it was first noticed that the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge had expired as indicated in the manner specified in Article 14 of this Order.

(4) For Article 13 of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-

### Parking Heters or Ticket Issuing Machines to be installed at Parking Places

- There shall be a parking meter on or in the vicinity of each parking bay in a parking place where parking is controlled by parking meters or where parking is controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine, there shall be a ticket issuing machine situated within a reasonable walking distance.
- (vi) For Article 14 of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-

### Indications by Parking Meter or by Ticket

- 14(1) For a parking place controlled by parking maters:
  - (a) Fayment of the initial charges for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by a pointer showing on a timescale on the parking meter or by means of a digital display on the parking meter of a period equal to the initial period for which payment was made by any such initial charge as is specified in Article 7 of this Order and thereafter until that period has elapsed how much of it at any time remains unexpired.
  - The expiry of the initial period for which the initial charge has been paid shall be indicated by the appearance on the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the wehicle is left of a yellow flag displaying the words "excess charge" of a digital display which flashes alternately the word "excess" and the amount of time since expiry of the initial period.
  - (c) The expiry of the period mentioned in Article 15 of this. Order (being the period for which a vehicle may remain in a parking place after the excess charge has been incurred) shall be indicated by the appearance on the parking meter of a red flag disclaying the word "penalty" or of a digital display which flaches alternately the word 'ponalty" and the anount of time since the expiry of the initial period.

14(2) For a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine:-

(a) Payment of the initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by the issue by a ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place of a ticket indicating that a charge has been paid for that occasion, and by the display of that ticket in the manner specified in Article 3(0) of this Order.

(b) The expiry of the initial period for which the initial charge has been paid shall be indicated on the ticket issued by the ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place.

(vii) For Article 15 of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-

- If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking bay controlled by a parking meter during the permitted hours the parking meter relating to the parking bay in which the vehicle is left gives the indication mentioned in paragraph (1)(b) of the last preceding Article, it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the inital charge has been duly paid or is treated under paragraph (1) or (2) of Article 26 of this Order as having been paid in respect of that vehicle and that the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge has already expired.
- If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine during the permitted hours no ticket issued by a ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place is displayed on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 3(4) it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the initial charge has not been paid.
- Mhero during the permitted hours a parking meter relating to a parking bay in which a vehicle is left gives the indication mentioned in paragraph (11(c) of the last preceding Artiple, or where a vehicle is left in a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine a vehicle has displayed on it a ticket issued by a ticket issuing machine and the time indicated on that ticket has expired by more than the period for which a vehicle may be left after the excess charge has been incurred as authorised by Article 10 of this Order, those indications shall:
  - (a) in any proceedings for an offence under paragraph (a) of Section 47(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 of leaving the vehicle in the parking place for lorger after the excess charge has been incurred than the time authorised by Article 15 of this Order, be evidence that it was so left and
  - (b) in any proceedings for an offence under the said paragraph (a) of failing duly to pay the excess charge, be evidence that that charge be incurred.
- twill) For article 22(3) of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-
  - Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) or paragraph (2) of this article shall thereupon:-

- (a) place or cause to be placed over any parking meters relating to the parking bays which are within that parking place or that part thereof hoods or other covers indicating that the use of the bays is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited, or
- (b) place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any parking place not controlled by parking meters and the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (ix) For Article 28 of the 1987 Order there was substituted the following Article:-

#### Examptions from Charges

- 26(1) A vehicle left during the permitted hours in a parking bay controlled by a parking meter and vacated by another vehicle after payment of the initial charge in respect of that other vehicle and so left before the expiration of the period for which the charge was paid shall be exempt from payment of the initial charge, if payment of that charge is not made in accordance with the provisions of article 2 of this Order on the leaving of the vehicle; and any vehicle so exempted shall be treated as if it had been left, and the initial charge paid in respect of it, at the time when that other vehicle was left and all the provisions of this Order shall apply, except that where a vehicle is left in a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine no person shall display on a vehicle left in a parking place during the permitted hours any ticket issued by a ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place other than the ticket issued by such a ticket issuing machine upon payment of the initial charge in respect of that vehicle.
- 26(2) If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a parking bay controlled by a parking meter there is on the parking meter relating to that bay a notice placed by a person duly authorised by the Council, indicating that the meter is out of order, that vehicle shall be exempt from the initial charge provided that it is removed within the maximum permitted initial period after the said meter is rectified.
- If at the time when a vehicle is left in a parking place controlled by the display of a ticket from a ticket issuing machine there is on every ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place a notice placed by a popular sury authorised by the Council, indicating that the ticket issuing machine is out of order, that vehicle shall be exempt from the initial charge provided that it is removed within the maximum permitted initial period ater a ticket issuing machine relating to that parking place is rectified.

- 26(4) If a vehicle exempted from the initial charge by virtue of the provisions of the last 2 preceding paragraphs is not removed within the maximum permitted period appropriate to that parking place the inital charge payable in respect of that period shall be treated as having been incurred and paid at the time when the vehicle was left in the parking place and all the provisions of this Order shall apply accordingly.
- 25(5) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge may be left in a parking place during the permitted hours without charge or compliance with any limitation of time.
- 28(8) Without prejudice to the generality of this Article, a vehicle to which this Article applies shall stand in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of Article 18 of this Order.
