

THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL
(KETTLEBRIDGE ROAD AREA, PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
(EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC) ORDER 2008

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 9 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time of any day in any of the sides of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the 6th day of May, 2008 and may be cited as The Sheffield City Council (Kettlebridge Road Area, Prohibition Of Waiting) (Experimental Traffic) Order 2008.
