## THE SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS AT SHEFFIELD) (AREA NO. 6) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER, 1980

The South Yorkshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

#### **DEFINITIONS**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the day of 1980 and may be cited as "The South Yorkshire County Council (Various Roads at Sheffield) (Area No. 6) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 1980.

#### 2. (1) In this Order

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 1975;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631:1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying -
  - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -
    - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; and
    - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle; and
  - (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- (3) Except where otherwise stated, any references in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

# PROHIBITION OF WAITING

3. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

# RESTRICTION OF WAITING

- 4. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive in the side of road referred to in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- 7. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on any day in the side of road referred to in Schedule 5 to this Order.
- 8. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between the hours of 5.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. on any day in any of the sides of road referred to in Schedule 6 to this Order.
- 9. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6.00~p.m. and 11.00~p.m. on any day in either of the sides of road referred to in Schedule 7 to this Order.

#### LIMITED WAITING

- 10. Save as provided in Article 11 and Article 13 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 8 to this Order -
  - (a) for a longer period than two hours; or
  - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road.

## EXCEPTIONS

- 11. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the sides of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -

- (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road;
- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
- (f) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said sides of road for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
- (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 12. Nothing in Articles, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the sides of road referred to in those Articles for a period of not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same side of road on the same day).
- 13. Nothing in Article 10 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait in any of the sides of road referred to in that Article
- 14. In so far as any provisions of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967, and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles other than stage carriages or express carriages in a bus stop area or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of that Order shall prevail;

# GENERAL

- 15. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.
- 16. The Orders specified in Schedule # to this Order are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to any of the lengths of road referred to in this Order.

- (v) the south-west side from a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with the north-western kerb line of Woodhead Road for a distance of 40 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- both sides between a point 17 metres north-west of the north-western kerb line of Asline Road and a point 21 N metres south-east of that kerb line.
- West side from its junction with the north western kerb line of School Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a north
- easterly direction.
  - both sides, at the south-western end, between the south-western kerb line of Abbeydale Road and a point 15 metres south-east of that kerb line.
    - both sides, at the northern end. between the south-eastern kerb line of Abbeydale Road and a point 61 metres south-east of that kerb line.
    - the eastern side from its junction (i) with the south eastern kerb line of Atlantic Road proper to its termination.

- the north side from its junction with the western kerb line of Abbeydale Road for a distance of 45 metres in a westerly direction.
  - the south side from its junction with the western kerb line of Abbeydale Road for a distance of 16 metres in a westerly direction.

BASLOW ROAD

- (1) the east carriageway between its junction with Glover Road and a point 17 metres north of that junction.
  - (ii) the east carriageway between a point 20 metres south of the south eastern kerb line of Milldale Road and a point 52 metres south of that kerb line.
- (iii) the south side between points 27 metres and 56 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Totley Hall Lane.

BASLOW ROAD SERVICE ROAD (Nos. 15-71)

- (i) the west side between its junction with Glover Road and a point 14 metres north of that junction.
  - the west side between its northern (ii)junction with Baslow Road and a point opposite a point on the east side of Baslow Road, 52 metres south of the south-eastern kerb line of Milldale Road .

(iii) the north side between a point 73 metres west of the western kerb line of Bannerdale Road and a point 41 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Bannerdale Road.

- (iv) the south side between a point 50 metres west of the western kerb line of Bannerdale Road and a point 78 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Bannerdale Road.
- (v) the north-west side from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with the south-western kerb line of Swaledale Road to a point 20 metres north-east of its junction with the north-eastern kerb line of Swaledale Road.
- (vi) the south-east side from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with the south-western kerb line of Coverdale Road to a point 10 metres north east of its junction with the north-eastern kerb line of Coverdale Road.
- (vii) both sides from the junction with Abbeydale Road for a distance of 60 metres in a south-westerly direction.

CAUSEWAY HEAD ROAD (DORE)

the south-east side between the southwestern kerb line of High Street and a point 20 metres north-west of that kerb line.

- (i) the north-west side from its junction with the northern kerb line of Sharrow Vale Road for a distance of 118 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- (ii) the south-east side from its junction with the northern kerb line of Sharrow Lane for a distance of 55 metres in a north-easterly direction.

CHARLOTTE ROAD

- (i) the south-west side between the south-eastern kerb line of Queens Road and a point 83 metres south-east of that kerb line.
- (ii) the north-east side between the eastern kerb line of Queens Road and a point 67 metres south-east of that kerb line.
- (iii) the north-east side between the north-western kerb line of Olive Grove Road, and a point 9 metres north west of that kerb line.
- (iv) the north-east side between a point 46 metres north-west of the north-western kerb line of Olive Grove Road and a point 85 metres north-west of that kerb line.



(v) the south-west side between the north-western kerb line of Olive Grove Road and the eastern kerb line of Heeley Bank Road.

  - (ii) the south-west side from its junction with the south-eastern kerb line of Cemetery Road for a distance of 8 metres in a south-easterly direction.
  - (iii) the south-west side from its junction with the north-western kerb line of Club Garden Road for a distance of 8 metres in a north-westerly direction.

CLUB GARDEN ROAD

- (i) the north-west side from its junction with the south-western kerb line of Cliff Street for a distance of 10 metres in a south-westerly direction.
  - (ii) the south-east side from a point 6 metres south-west of the south-western kerb line of Cliff Street for a distance of 9 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(iii) the west side from its junction with the south-eastern kerb line of Mount Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

CLUB GARDEN ROAD/ MOUNT STREET - the north-west side from a point 40 metres south-west of its junction with the south-western kerb line of Cliff Street for a distance of 23 metres in a south-westerly direction.

CLUB GARDEN WALK

- both sides - the whole.

COBNAR ROAD
