# THE SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL (BUS PRIORITY) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1991 (CONSOLIDATION AMENDMENT) ORDER 2015

The Sheffield City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- The Sheffield City Council (Bus Priority) (Consolidation) Order 1991 (as amended) shall have effect as though:
  - a) In DEFINITIONS 2(1) thereto for the definition of "Authorised Vehicles" there was substituted the following definition:-

"Authorised Vehicles" means:

- Private Hire Vehicles with suitable side markings, as approved by Sheffield City Council, operating under a licence issued by a Local Authority; or
- Vehicles with suitable side markings, as approved by Sheffield City Council, carrying persons on behalf of the National Health Service for medical reasons; or
- Vehicles with suitable side markings, as approved by Sheffield City Council, being operated on behalf of a Local Authority for educational or care purposes; or
- Vehicles carrying valid exemption permits issued by Sheffield City Council to residents of Haggard Road, Kipling Road, Rider Road, Rudyard Mews, Rudyard Road and Treswell Crescent.
- b) For Article 11(F) thereto there was substituted the following Article:-
  - 11(F) Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle, taxi, tramcar or authorised vehicle shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform proceed between the hours of 7:00am to 11:00am and 3:00pm to 7:00pm Monday to Saturday in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3F to this Order.
- c) In Article 12(1) thereto for reference to Article 11F there was substituted reference to Article 11F and Article 11G.
- d) For Article 13 thereto there was substituted the following Article:-
  - 13 Nothing in Article 11 of this Order shall render it:-
    - lawful for a taxi or authorised vehicle to proceed in the Peaks Mount Bus Gates;
    - unlawful for a vehicle for a vehicle being used by or on behalf of a bus operator to proceed in the Peaks Mount Bus Gates;
    - lawful for a vehicle carrying a valid exemption permit issued by the City Council to a resident of Haggard Road, Kipling Road, Rider Road, Rudyard Road or Treswell Crescent to proceed in any bus lane, bus gate or bus/tram gate other than the Langsett Road bus/tram gate as described in Schedule 3F to this Order.

- e) In the title to Schedule 3F thereto for "Between 7:00am and 7:00pm on all days" there was substituted "Between 7:00am and 11:00am and between 3:00pm and 7:00pm Monday to Saturday".
- f) There was included the following Article:-
  - Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order no vehicle other than a bus, pedal cycle, taxi or authorised vehicle shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform proceed between the hours of 7:00am to 7:00pm Monday to Saturday in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3G to this Order.
- g) In Schedule 1 Part 1 there was included the following item:-

#### Road

#### **Description**

4A. Moore Street

That area of the north east bound carriageway of Moore Street which forms the right turning lane at its junction with Fitzwilliam Gate which is bounded:-

- a) on the south east side by the south eastern kerb line of the right turning lane;
- b) on the north west side by the authorised traffic sign.
- h) In Schedule 1 Part 2 thereto there were included the following items:-

#### Road

#### **Description**

**Broad Street** 

That area of carriageway of Broad Street from a point 40 metres north east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Old Street to its junction with Park Square and which is bounded:-

- a) on the south east and south side by the south eastern and southern kerb line thereof;
- b) on the north west and north side by the authorised traffic sign.

Harvest Lane

That area of carriageway of Harvest Lane from a point 100 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Rowland Street to its junction with Mowbray Street and which is bounded:-

- a) on the north east side by the north eastern kerb line thereof;
- b) on the south west side by the authorised traffic sign.

#### Mowbray Street

That area of carriageway of Mowbray Street from its junction with Harvest Lane to its junction with the western kerb line of Pitsmoor Road and which is bounded:-

- a) on the north east side by the north eastern kerb line thereof:
- b) on the south west side by the authorised traffic sign.

#### Queens Road

That area of carriageway of Queens Road from a point 260 metres south west of its junction with the southern kerb line of Charlotte Road to a point 230 metres north of its junction with the northern kerb line of Duchess Road and which is bounded:-

- a) on the west side by the western kerb line thereof;
- b) on the east side by the authorised traffic sign.
- i) In Schedule 1 Part 3 thereto there were included the following items:-

#### Road

#### Description

#### **Broad Street**

That area of carriageway of Broad Street from a point 40 metres north east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Old Street to its junction with Park Square and which is bounded:-

- a) on the south east and south side by the south eastern and southern kerb line thereof;
- b) on the north west and north side by the authorised traffic sign.

#### Harvest Lane

That area of carriageway of Harvest Lane from a point 100 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Rowland Street to its junction with Mowbray Street and which is bounded:-

- a) on the north east side by the north eastern kerb line thereof;
- b) on the south west side by the authorised traffic sign.

#### Mowbray Street

That area of carriageway of Mowbray Street from its junction with Harvest Lane to its junction with the western kerb line of Pitsmoor Road and which is bounded:-

- a) on the north east side by the north eastern kerb line thereof;
- b) on the south west side by the authorised traffic sign.

#### Queens Road

That area of carriageway of Queens Road from a point 260 metres south west of its junction with the southern kerb line of Charlotte Road to a point 230 metres north of its junction with the northern kerb line of Duchess Road and which is bounded:-

- a) on the west side by the western kerb line thereof
- b) on the east side by the authorised traffic sign.
- j) In Schedule 3 thereto there was included the following item:-

6AA Loxley New Road That length of carriageway which forms the bus only link between Loxley New Road and Holme Lane.

k) There was included the following Schedule:-

## SCHEDULE 3G BUS GATES 7:00AM TO 7:00PM MONDAY TO SATURDAY

<u>Description</u>
The north west bound carriageway of Duke Street from its junction with School Lane/Crown Place to its junction with Park Square.
The north east bound carriageway of South Lane from its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Young Street for a distance of 23 metres.
