

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (LUDLOW RESIDENTS PARKING ZONES)
(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2020**

Shropshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49, and Part IV of Schedule 9, and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This order shall come into operation on 3 February 2020 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Ludlow Residents Parking Zones) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2020.
2. Schedule 2A – Red Zone of The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended as follows:
 - i) The reference to Brand Lane is re-written to read: “Brand Lane Its whole length”;
 - ii) “Church Walk Its whole length” is hereby added to the list of eligible addresses;
 - iii) The reference to College Street is deleted.
3. Schedule 2B – Blue Area of The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended by:
 - i. the addition of the following streets and properties:

Friar’s Walk	The Hideaway
Packer Court	Its whole length
Pynfold Gardens	Its whole length
Warrington Gardens	Its whole length
 - ii. the reference to College Street is re-written to read:

College Street	Its whole length

4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
