## (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS IN LUDLOW AND SHREWSBURY) (AMENDMENT) (PART 2) ORDER 2018

The Shropshire Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 45, 46, and 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This order shall come into operation on 19 November 2018 and may be cited as the Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Various Roads in Ludlow and Shrewsbury) (Amendment) (Part 2) Order 2018.
- 2. A) Article 8A of The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended by Article 8A of this Order to incorporate adoption of banding levels and/or new hourly tariff rates for all pay and display parking places in Ludlow.
  - B) The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended to incorporate changes as part of the new Parking Strategy. The following changes to the Order are due to change of time when charges will be made for Shrewsbury and Ludlow, introduction of banding levels and/or hourly tariff rates, adopting linear model pricing strategy and capturing enhanced methods of payment:

The following schedules are hereby amended:

- Ludlow: Schedule 2 (A) Red Zone
- Ludlow: Schedule 2 (C) Pay and Display and Permit holders only (Blue Area)
- C) Permitted Hours on the Plans for Loading Areas:
  - The parts of roads identified as such on the Plans within this Amendment Order are hereby designated to be used subject to the provision of The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2009, as loading areas and all existing Plans are superseded by the Plans of this Amendment Order. Loading areas may be used subject to formerly mentioned provisions on such days and during such permitted hours as are specified on Plans.
- D) All maximum and minimum stay, and No Return restrictions relating to the Pay & Display bays in the Red Residents Parking Zone in Ludlow are hereby revoked.

3.	The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
