## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS, OSWESTRY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2022

Shropshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49, and Part IV of Schedule 9, and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

- This order shall come into operation on 24 October 2022 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition And Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Various Roads, Oswestry) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2022.
- 2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended to incorporate the following changes:
  - i. The following side of road in Oswestry is deleted from the Schedule for Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 40 Mins No Return 1 Hour:

Beatrice Street	From a point 4.2 metres north-east of its former junction with
(north-west side)	Albert Road to its junction with Cambrian Place.

ii. The following side of road in Oswestry is added to the Schedule for Loading Only:

Beatrice Street	From a point 4 metres north-east of its former junction
(north-west side)	with Albert Road for a distance of 14 metres in a north-
	easterly direction.

iii. The following side of road in Oswestry is added to the Schedule for Limited waiting Mon-Sat 8 am - 6 pm 40 mins no return 1 hour:

Beatrice Street	From a point 18 metres north-east of its former
(north-west side)	junction with Albert Road to its junction with
	Cambrian Place.

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
