THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (WYLE COP AND DOGPOLE, SHREWSBURY) (VARIOUS EXPERIMENTAL RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2020 (MODIFICATIONS NO. 1) ORDER 2020

Shropshire Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of their powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into effect on 19 December 2020 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Wyle Cop and Dogpole, Shrewsbury) (Various Experimental Restrictions) Order 2020 (Modifications No. 1) Order 2020.
- 2. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context requires otherwise, be construed as a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders revoked by this Order were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
- 5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 6. If a court, the Department for Transport, the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or the Traffic Enforcement Centre declares any part of this Order to be invalid or unenforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order.
- 7. The Shropshire Council (Wyle Cop and Dogpole, Shrewsbury) (Various Experimental Restrictions) Order 2020 is hereby modified as follows:
 - i. The following side of road is removed from Schedule 4 Loading Bay:

"Wyle Cop From a point in line with the property boundary (north side) of No's 11 and 12 Wyle Cop to a point in line with the property boundary of No's 14 and 15 Wyle Cop"

ii. Schedule 3 – No Waiting or Loading At Any Time is re-written to read:

SCHEDULE 3

Restricted Zone – No Waiting or Loading At Any Time

Sides of Road in Shrewsbury in the County of Shropshire

Wyle Cop From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Dogpole to its junction with Beeches Lane

(north side)

Wyle Cop From its junction with Beeches Lane to a point 119.9 metres south-east of its junction with Milk Street (south side)

> From a point 107.3 metres south-east of its junction with Milk Street to its junction with High Street

Schedule 4 will be re-written to read: iii.

"SCHEDULE 4"

No Waiting or Loading 11:00am-4:00pm Loading Bay - 7.30am-11am and 4.00pm-8.00pm

Side of Road in Shrewsbury in the County of Shropshire

Wyle Cop Between points 107.3 metres and 119.9 metres (south side) south-east of its junction with Milk Street"

- iv. Article 14 is re-written to read:
 - "14. Save as provided in Article 15, the side of road specified in Schedule 4 is hereby designated to be used as a loading and unloading only area between 7:30am and 11am, and between 4:00pm and 8:00pm. Save as provided in Article 13, waiting and loading will be prohibited between 11:00am and 4:00pm."
- Article 15 is re-written to read: ٧.
 - "15. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer or a parking enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the side of road specified in Schedule 4, between 7:30am and 11am, and between 4:00pm and 8:00pm, except for the loading or unloading of goods in connection with nearby trade or business premises.
- 8. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
