ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

(TEME STREET, MARKET STREET, CROSS STREET AND PEMBROKE AVENUE, TENBURY)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1991

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 and with the consent of Shropshire County Council so far as relates to the length of road described in Second Schedule to this Order, hereby make the following Order:-

- The County of Worcester (Various Streets, Tenbury)(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1968 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) the reference to Teme Street in Column 2 of the Schedule thereof were amended to read:-
 - "East from a point 35 metres (114 feet) north of its junction with Market Street to a point 158 metres (518 feet) south of its junction with A456.
 - (b) the reference to Teme Street in Column 3 of the Schedule thereof were amended to read:-
 - "West from a point 20 metres (66 feet) north of its junction with Market Street to a point 158 metres (518 feet) south of its junction with A456.
 - (c) the reference to Market Street in Column 2 of the Schedule thereof were amended to read:-
 - "North from its junction with Market Square for a distance of 14 metres (45 feet) in an easterly direction."
 - (d) the reference to Market Street in Column 3 of the Schedule thereof were amended to read:-
 - "North from a point 70 metres (230 feet) west of its junction Teme Street to a point 14 metres (45 feet) east of its junction with Market Square."
 - (e) the reference to Cross Street in Column 2 of the Schedule thereof were amended to read:-
 - "West from its junction with Market Square for a distance of 14 metres (45 feet) in a southerly direction and from its junction with Berrington Road for a distance of 14 metres (45 feet) in a northerly direction.
 - (f) the reference to Cross Street in Column 3 of the Schedule thereof were amended to read:-
 - "West from a point 34 metres (112 feet) south of its junction with Market Square to a point 14 metres (45 feet) north of its junction with Berrington Road".
- Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length and sides of lengths of roads in the Town of Tenbury in the District of Leominster in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the First Schedule to this Order and in that length of road in the Parish of Burford in the District of South Shropshire in the County of Shropshire specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

- Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any
 vehicle to wait in the lengths and sides of lengths of roads referred to in the Article
 for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded onto and/or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths and sides of lengths of roads referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said lengths and sides of lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collect ing postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of removing furniture and effects from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
 - (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths and sides of lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same lengths and sides of lengths of roads on the same day).
- 5. (1) In this Order:-
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;
 - "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986;
 - "parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631:1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.
 - (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
 - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when:-
 - in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; and
 - in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front

or near side of the vehicle;

- (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- 6. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 9th day of December 1991 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Teme Street, Market Street, Cross Street and Pembroke Avenue, Tenbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991.

Length and sides of lengths of roads in the Town of Tenbury in the District of Leominster in the County of Hereford and Worcester.

Teme Street (west side)

from its junction with Market Street for a distance of 20

metres (66 feet) in a northerly direction.

(east side)

from its junction with Market Street for a distance of 35

metres (114 feet) in a northerly direction.

(both sides)

from a point 50 metres (164 feet) south of its junction with A456 for a distance of approximately 108 metres (354

feet) in a southerly direction.

Market Street (north side)

from its junction of Teme Street for a distance of 70 metres

(230 feet) in a westerly direction.

Cross Street (west side)

from a point 14.5 metres (47 feet 6 ins) north of Westfield

Terrace for a distance of 20 metres (66 feet) in a southerly

direction.

(west side)

from its junction with Berrington Road for a distance of 70

metres (230 feet) in a southerly direction.

(east side)

from its junction with Pembroke Avenue for a distance of

25 metres (82 feet) in a southerly direction.

Pembroke Avenue

(both sides)

from its junction with Cross Street for a distance of

20 metres (66feet) in an easterly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Length of road in the Parish of Burford in the District of South Shropshire in the County of Shropshire.

Teme Street (both sides)

from its junction with A456 for a distance of 50 metres

(164 feet) in a southerly direction.
