The Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Parts IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This order shall come into operation on 29 March 2010 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Amendment) (North Drive, Park Hall) Order 2010.
- 2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended by the addition of the sides of road specified in the Schedule to this order to Schedule 1.01 (No Waiting At Any Time), and to Tile BL 35.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

Sides of road at Park Hall in the County of Shropshire

North Drive North-east side:	From its junction with Twmpath Lane for a distance of 161 metres in a south-easterly direction.
North Drive South-west side:	From its junction with Twmpath Lane for a distance of 159 metres in a south-easterly direction.
