THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (SHRUBBERY GARDENS, WEM) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2010

The Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Parts IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

- This order shall come into operation on 19 February 2010 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Shrubbery Gardens, Wem) (Amendment) Order 2010.
- 2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended as follows:
 - Schedule 1.01 (No Waiting At Any Time), and Map Tile BX77 are hereby amended by the deletion of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order;
 - b) Schedule 1.01 (No Waiting At Any Time), and Map Tile BX77 are hereby amended by the addition of the sides of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order:
 - c) a new Schedule 1.18 (Prohibition of Stopping on School Keep Clear Markings) is created comprising the side of road specified in Schedule 3 (Map Tile BX77) to this order;
 - d) a new Article 10A is created and will read as follows:

"School Keep Clear Markings

Save as provided in Articles 13 and 14 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer or community safety officer, cause or permit any vehicle or a vehicle of a specific class to wait on any School Keep Clear Marking during the restricted hours as specified on the Plans."

 The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE 1

Sides of roads and lengths of roads at Wem in the County of Shropshire

REVOKED Prohibition of Waiting at any time

- Shrubbery Gardens a) From its junction with Station Road to a point 23 metres west of that junction.
 - b) Between a point 57 metres and 69 metres west of its junction with Cherry Close.
 - c) Between a point 41 metres and 77 metres south of its junction with Queensway.

SCHEDULE 2

Prohibition of Waiting at any time

Sides of roads at Wem in the County of Shropshire

Park Road (east side)	From its junction with Shrubbery Gardens for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
Shrubbery Gardens (north side)	Between a point 118 metres south of its junction with Queensway and a point 69 metres east of its junction with Park Road.
Shrubbery Gardens (south side)	Between the east side of its junction with Park Road and a point 69 metres east of that junction.
Shrubbery Gardens (north and south side)	From its junction with Station Road for a distance of 23 metres in a westerly direction.
Shrubbery Gardens (south and east side)	From a point 57 metres west of its junction with the centre of Cherry Close to a point 79 metres south of its junction with Queensway.
Shrubbery Gardens (east side and north side)	From a point 40 metres south of its junction with Queensway to a point 57 metres west of its junction with the centre of Cherry Close.
Shrubbery Gardens (west side and north side)	From a point 92 metres south of its junction with Queens way and 38 metres east of its junction with Park Road.

SCHEDULE 3

Side of road at Wem in the County of Shropshire

Prohibition of stopping on School Keep Clear markings

Shrubbery Gardens (west side)

From a point 28 metres south of its junction with Queens way to a point 92 metres south of its junction with Queensway.
