

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (WATERGATE STEET AND DODINGTON,
WHITCHURCH) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2012**

The Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Parts IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This order shall come into operation on 5 January 2012 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Watergate Street and Dodington, Whitchurch) (Amendment) Order 2012.
2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended to incorporate the following changes:

Schedule 1.13 (No Waiting between 8:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday) will be amended by:

- i. the deletion of the following items:

Watergate From its junction with Mill Street to a point 70 metres
(south-west side) south east of its junction with Bark Hill

Watergate From a point 7 metres south of its junction with White
(north-east side) Lion Meadow to a point 87 metres north of its junction
with Bridgewater Street.

- ii. the addition of the following items:

Watergate Street From its junction with Mill Street to its junction with
(south-west side) Bark Hill.

Watergate Street From a point 7 metres south of its junction with White
(north-east side) Lion Meadow to its junction with Bark Hill.

Dodington From its junction with Bark Hill for a distance of 70
(south-west side) metres in a south easterly direction.

Dodington From its junction with Bark Hill to a point 87 metres
(north-east side) north of its junction with Bridgewater Street.

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
