THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS, ALVELEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2012

The Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Parts IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

- This order shall come into operation on 14 December 2012 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Various Roads, Alveley) (Amendment) Order 2012.
- 2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended to incorporate the following changes:

The revocation of the No Waiting At Any Time restrictions set out below:

Daddlebrook Road (north-west side)	Between points 119.8 and 151m north east of its junction with Peacock Hill.
Daddlebrook Road (south-east side)	Between points 119.8 and 150m north east of its junction with Peacock Hill

The addition of the No Waiting At Any Time restrictions set out below:

Daddlebrook Road (both sides)	Between points 119.8 and 169m north-east of its junction with Peacock Hill.
Daddlebrook Road (north-west side)	From a point 17m south of its junction with Cooks Cross to a point 10m north of this junction.
Cooks Cross (north-west side)	From its junction with Daddlebrook Road to lamp column 54 in a north-westerly direction (a distance of 16m)
Cooks Cross (north-east side)	From its junction with Daddlebrook Road to the southern-most part of the parking area outside the shops, in a north-easterly direction.
Lime Close	From its junction with Cooks Cross for a

distance of 12m in an easterly direction.

 The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
