

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (FROGMORE ROAD, MARKET DRAYTON)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2013

The Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Parts IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This order shall come into operation on 27 September 2013 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Frogmore Road, Market Drayton) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2013.
2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended to incorporate the following changes:
 - a) The following side of road will be deleted from Schedule 1.01 (No Waiting At Any Time):

Frogmore Road (west side)	from south of the rear access to the Festival Drayton Centre in a north and then easterly direction to the junction with Cheshire Street.

 - b) The following sides of road are added to Schedule 1.01 (No Waiting At Any Time):

Frogmore Road (west side)	From a point six meters north-west of the vehicular access to property number 3 Frogmore Road, in a north and then easterly direction to the junction with Cheshire Street.
	From south of the rear access to the Festival Drayton Centre to a point six meters north-east of the vehicular access to property number 3 Frogmore Road.
 - c) The following side of road is added to Schedule 3.01 (Loading Bay):

Frogmore Road (west side)	for a length of approximately six meters located north-west of the vehicular access to property number 3 Frogmore Road.

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
