

**SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2011 (VARIOUS CAR PARKS,
SHREWSBURY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2014**

Shropshire Council (hereinafter called “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This order shall come into operation on 18 April 2014 and may be cited as the Shropshire Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2011 (Various Car Parks, Shrewsbury) (Amendment) Order 2014.
2. The Shropshire Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2011 is hereby amended to incorporate the following changes:

- Article 45 is re-written to read:

“Payment

Subject to Part 4 ‘Exemptions’, no person shall cause or permit any Vehicle to be Parked in a Parking Place without arranging for the appropriate Daily Charge (if any) to be paid in accordance with the scale of current charges as specified by notice at the Parking Place and as specified in the Schedules and if using services offered by the ‘Cashless Service Provider’ any Convenience charge imposed by the ‘Cashless Parking Provider.”

The ‘Cashless Parking Provider’ may offer additional services to the persons using the cashless service provision and the costs for such provision will be borne by the customer should they wish to use any additional services.

Any costs incurred by the customer by using their phone or other suitable electronic means for cashless parking forms part of the customers own service agreement with their provider of the product and all costs shall be borne by the customer under their own terms and agreement.

- Article 46 is re-written to read:

“Means of payment

The Daily Charges and Convenience Charge referred to in the preceding Article shall be payable in the manner as specified by notice_at the Parking Place.”

- Article 48 is re-written to read:

“The Driver of a Vehicle, upon Parking the Vehicle in a Parking Bay, shall immediately ensure that a Pay and Display Ticket is obtained from a Ticket Machine situated at that Parking Place at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of Daily Charges as specified by notice at the Parking Place and as specified in the Schedules, unless a valid Season

Ticket or Permit is to be used for the Vehicle, or the Driver has paid for their specified parking period by phone or other suitable electronic means”

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
