

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES)  
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS, CLEOBURY MORTIMER)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2015**

Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Parts IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This order shall come into operation on 2 October 2015 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Various Roads, Cleobury Mortimer) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015.
2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended to incorporate the following changes:
  - a) The addition of the following side of road to Schedule 1.01 (No Waiting At Any Time):

Childe Road (north side)	From a point 39m from the junction with High Street, for a distance of 75m in a north-easterly direction.

  - b) The addition of the following side of road to a new Schedule (No Waiting Mon–Fri 8.00am–4pm):

Childe Road (south side)	From a point 39m from the junction with High Street, for a distance of 71 m in a north-easterly direction.

  - c) The addition of the following sides of road to a new Schedule (Disabled Parking Bay) (3 hours No Return for 1 Hour):

High Street/Church Street (A4117) (north side)	From a point 84m east of the junction with Childe Road for a distance of 7m in an easterly direction.
High Street/Church Street (A4117) (south side)	From a point 1m east of the junction with Eagle Lane, for a distance of 7m in an easterly direction  From a point 71 m east of the junction with Eagle Lane for a distance of 7m in an easterly direction.
3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
