THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDGNORTH) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2016

Shropshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 and having regard to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

- This Order shall come into effect on 1 April 2016 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Various Roads, Bridgnorth) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2016.
- 2. The Shropshire Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended as follows:
 - a) Schedule 1(B) is revoked and replaced with the following revised Schedule 1(B):

Schedule 1 (B) – Shared parking places – Limited Waiting and Permit Holders Monday to Saturday 8.00am to 6.00pm

Residents (to include owners of businesses) in the roads listed in Column 1 of the table below are eligible to apply for up to two permits per household or business premises, at a cost of £50 each (permits will last for 12 months), to allow them to park in the residents parking areas (as defined in the Plans within drawings RP/05/WV164AB/A, RP/05/WV164BJ/B, RP/05/WV164AL/B, RP/05/WV163EL/B, RP/05/WV164DW/A and RP/05/WV164BG/B) on the corresponding street specified in Column 2 of the table.

Residents (to include owners of businesses) in the roads listed in Column 1 of the table below may apply for visitor permits which will allow their visitors when displaying a valid permit, in accordance with this Order, to park on the corresponding street specified in Column 2 of the table. Permits will be available in books of 10 (full days) or in books of 20 (half-days) at a cost of £10 per book for the first 3 books, and £50 per book for all subsequent books. Residents may apply for an unlimited number of books.

The proprietor of a hotel, guest house, bed & breakfast, self catering or holiday let establishment the postal address of which is in Low Town, Bridgnorth (Low Town is as defined in row 5 of Column 1 in the table) may apply for visitor permits which will allow their guests, when displaying a valid permit, in accordance with this Order, to park on the corresponding street specified in Column 2 of the table. Permits will be available in books of 10 (full days) or in books of 20 (half-days) at a cost of £40 per book, and proprietors or managers may receive an unlimited number of books per guest room for a hotel, guest house, bed & breakfast, self catering or holiday let establishment in Low Town, Bridgnorth (as defined in row 5 of Column 1 in the table).

b) Schedule 1(F) is revoked and replaced with the following revised Schedule 1(F):

Schedule 1 (F) – Underhill Street Residents parking scheme Shared parking places – 40 Minutes Limited Waiting and Permit Holders Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 6.00pm

Streets where residents are eligible for permits (all properties unless otherwise indicated)

Residents in Castle Court, The Bakehouse, Bakers Mews, Stoneway House, 1-2 Underhill Street, 4-12 Underhill Street, 40 and 42-46 Underhill Street, and April Cottage (Library Steps).are eligible to purchase a permit, at a cost of £50 each (permits will last for 12 months), to allow them to park in the following residents parking areas:

	a) From a point 14 metres north of St Mary's Steps to a point 16 metres south of St Mary's Steps
(east side)	point 16 metres south of St Mary's Steps

Underhill Street (east side)	b) Between a point 105 metres south of St Mary's Steps and a point 131 metres south of St Mary's Steps
Underhill Street (east side)	c) Between a point 149 metres south of St Mary's Steps and a point 173 metres south of St Mary's Steps
Underhill Street (west side)	From a point 48 metres south of St Mary's Steps for a distance of 39 metres in a southerly direction.

Residents in the roads listed above may apply for visitor permits which will allow their visitors when displaying a valid permit, in accordance with this Order, to park in the residents parking area specified above. Permits will be available in books of 10 (full days) or in books of 20 (half-days) at a cost of £10 per book for the first 3 books, and £50 per book for all subsequent books. Residents may apply for an unlimited number of books.




