- SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL makes this Order in exercise of its powers under sections
 and 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, regulation 23 of the Local Authorities Traffic
 Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and any other enabling powers.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published.
- 3. The sole effect of this Order is to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of a previous experimental order made under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The previous experimental order is named 'The Borough of Slough (Amendment No.19) (Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2010) (Experimental) (Order 7 of 2013) ('the Experimental Order').
- 4. The Experimental Order, which is continued indefinitely whilst this Order is in force, introduced a combination of pay and display parking places from 9am 5pm from Monday Saturday, and No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on Waterside Drive. These measures were brought info force by amending the Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2010 ('the 2010 Order') by:
 - (a) Deleting the items relating to Waterside Drive from Schedule 2.01 of the 2010 Order;
 - (b) Adding the wording set out in Schedule A of this Order to Schedule 2.01 of the 2010 Order;
 - (c) Deleting the items relating to Waterside Drive from Schedule 3.02 of the 2010 Order;
 - (d) Adding the wording set out in Schedule B of this Order to Schedule 9.01 of the 2010 Order; and

(e) Adding the wording set out in Schedule C of this Order to Schedule 9.02 of the 2010 Order.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH (AMENDMENT NO.31) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS' PARKING ORDER 2010) ORDER 2014 (ORDER 5 OF 2014)

Slough Borough Council is making the above experimental Traffic Regulation Order to improve access for HGV's and Emergency Service Vehicles using Waterside Drive. By sealing this order, parked vehicles will be done so in a staggered manor that allows easy access for large HGV's and Emergency Service Vehicles and restricts the ability for vehicles to be double parked. Being in close proximity to Langley Train Station, Pay and Display parking is offered to commuters with long term parking requirements as well as short stay visitors to the area. Parking charges will be in line with those at Langley Train Station.

The order is being made under an experimental order to trial these new restrictions, and also to allow changes to be made to the scheme if there are negative impacts on the surrounding roads.
