Sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2010 ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING POINT PARKING PLACES VARIATION ORDER 2013 (Order 18 of 2013)

1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL makes this Order in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2013

3. While this Order is in operation, the Borough of Slough Off-Street Parking Places (Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) Order 2010 ('the 2010 Order') shall have the following effect:

- a) Schedule 1 of this Order introduces additional wording to Part 1 paragraph 2 of the 2010 Order;
- b) Schedule 2 of this Order replaces the title relating to Part 2 paragraphs 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the 2010 Order;
- c) Schedule 3 of this Order replaces Part 2 paragraph 5(c) and introduces (d) to the 2010 Order;
- d) Schedule 4 of this Order replaces Part 2 paragraph 7(c) and introduces (d) to the 2010 Order;
- e) Schedule 5 of this Order replaces Part 2 paragraph 8 (b) of the 2010 Order;
- f) Schedule 6 of this Order introduces Articles 32A and 32B to Part 2 of the 2010 Order; and
- g) Schedule 7 of this Order introduces Article 38 to Part 3 to the 2010 Order.



### SCHEDULE 1

"Electrically Propelled Vehicle" means a vehicle in which the electrical motive power is derived from any electrical storage battery which is not connected to any source of power when the vehicle is in motion;

"Hybrid Electrically Propelled Vehicle" means a vehicle primarily powered by an electrical storage battery;

"Charging Parking Place" means a Parking Place containing infrastructure that will allow the battery of an Electrically Propelled Vehicle or Hybrid Electrically Propelled Vehicle to be charged.

#### SCHEDULE 2

DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES. PARKING PLACES FOR SOLO MOTORCYCLES. PARKING PLACES FOR ELECTRICALLY PROPELLED VEHICLES AND HYBRID ELECTRICALLY PROPELLED VEHICLES. SEASON TICKET HOLDER PARKING PLACES

## SCHEDULE 3

(c) Electrically Propelled Vehicles or Hybrid Electrically Propelled Vehicles; or

(d) any specifically identified individual or organisation to whom a season ticket has been issued by the Council in accordance with the provision in Article 4

#### SCHEDULE 4

(c) Electrically Propelled vehicles or hybrid electrically propelled vehicles - provided that such vehicles are parked in a parking space which has been allocated for electrically propelled vehicles or hybrid electrically propelled vehicles in accordance with the provision of Article 5(c) whilst being charged;

(d) Any Motor Vehicle or Motorcycle provided that such vehicles are parked in a Parking Space which has been allocated for that individual or organisation in accordance with the provision of Article 5(d).

# SCHEDULE 5

(b) Where in this Order a Parking Space(s) have been allocated for use by any individual or organisation pursuant to Article 5(d) no Driver shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle or Motorcycle to enter or wait in such Parking Space unless

authorised to do so by Slough Borough Council or the individual or organisation to whom the Parking Space(s) have been allocated

#### SCHEDULE 6

32A. Electrically Propelled Vehicles and Hybrid Electrically Propelled Vehicles shall not be parked in a Charging Parking Place for a period of time exceeding that indicated on any sign that is placed within the charging parking place. Any such contravention shall result in a penalty charge being payable.

32B. Any Motor Vehicle or Motor Cycle that is not an Electrically Propelled Vehicle or Hybrid Electrically Propelled Vehicle is not permitted to park in a Charging Parking Place. Any such contravention shall result in a Penalty Charge being payable.

#### SCHEDULE 7

38. Any Vehicle that is not an Electrically Propelled Vehicle or Hybrid Electrically Propelled Vehicle is not permitted to park in a Charging Parking Place. Any such contravention shall result in a Penalty Charge being payable.
