WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS' PARKING

ORDER 2006

The Council of the Borough of Slough in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2), 4(1), (2) and (3), 19, 32(1), (2) and (3), 35, 35(c), 37, 45(1), (2) and (6), 46(1) and (2), 46(A)(1), 49(1)(b), 49(2), (4), (5) and (6), 51(1) and (2), 53(1), (2) and (3), 61(1) and (4), 63A (1) and (2), 65(1), 68(2), 69(1), 71(1), 92(1), 101, 102(2)(a) and 116 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and having regard to Section 122 of that Act and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act and in accordance with The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Slough) Order 2003 made by the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 37 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 this Order forms part of a general scheme of traffic control whose boundary is the outer boundary of the Slough Special Parking Area.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Order shall be cited as "The Borough of Slough Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2006 and shall have effect from 27th December 2006.

REVOCATION

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into effect of this Order any prohibitions or restrictions of waiting as respects vehicles effective in the area designated by the Secretary of State as a Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area in the Borough of Slough prior to this Order coming into effect relating to any of the lengths of road described herein are revoked to the extent that this Order takes effect.

<u>PART I</u>

DEFINITIONS

In this Order:

"the Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and references to Section numbers are to Sections of that Act unless otherwise stated,

"the 1991 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1991,

"authorised taxi rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 to The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Direction 2002,

"bus" has the meaning given by Regulation 22 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002,

"business" means any business whose usual place of business is at premises, the postal address of which is in a road specified in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 to this Order,

"business permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Articles 18 to 23 of this Order,

"carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles but excludes any "lay-by"

"conditions of waiting" has the meaning given by Article 35 of this Order,

"controlled days" has the meaning given by Article 35 of this Order,

"controlled hours" has the meaning given by Article 35 of this Order

"the Council" means Slough Borough Council,

"designated parking place" means a parking place designated under this Order forming part of this general scheme of parking control,

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000,

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000,

"driver" in relation to a vehicle means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was parked,

"footway" has the meaning given by Section 329 of the Highways Act 1980,

"goods" includes postal packets, currencies or other valuables of any description

"goods vehicle" has the meaning given by Section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988,

"goods vehicle loading bay" means an area designated by this Order for the loading of goods,

"hackney carriage" has the meaning given by Section 13(3) of the Transport Act 1985,

"heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 20(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988,

"heavy goods vehicle" has the meaning given by Section 20(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988,

"invalid carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act,

"loading bay" means an area on a road which is designated as a loading bay by virtue of Article 9 of this Order,

"local service" has the meaning given by Section 2 of the Transport Act 1985,

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act,

"owner" in relation to a vehicle has the meaning given by paragraph 1(1)(b) of Schedule 6 to the Act,

"parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act,

"parking disc" has the meaning given by Regulation 4(3)(ii) of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England)Regulations 2000,

"parking place" means an area on or beside a highway designated as such by this Order,

"parking space" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle,

"parking ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine and includes a parking device,

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver and not drawing a trailer,

"penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the 1991 Act and following approval by the Secretary of State which is due to be paid to the Council following the issue of a penalty charge notice and within 28 days of the issue of that notice,

"penalty charge notice" means a notice which complies with the requirement of Section 66(3) of the 1991 Act and which is fixed to a vehicle or given to the person appearing to be in charge of the vehicle by or under the authority of a parking attendant,

"permit holder" means a person to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of 18 to 23 of this Order,

"reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the 1991 Act and following approval by the Secretary of State which is due to be paid to the Council following the issue of a penalty charge notice and within 14 days of the issue of that notice,

"resident" means a person whose usual place of abode, or a business whose usual place of business is at premises , the postal address of which is in a road or part of a road specified in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 to this Order,

"resident permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Articles 18 to 23 of this Order,

"restricted road" means all roads or sides of roads specified within the Schedules to this Order,

"specified road" means any road or side of road in the Borough of Slough specified in this Order,

"statutory undertaker" has the meaning given by Section 48(4) of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991,

"Taxi" has the same meaning as "hackney carriage",

"ticket machine" means an apparatus of a type and design in accordance with and approved by the Secretary of State being an apparatus designed to indicate the time and to issue parking devices indicating payment of a parking charge under the provisions of this Order and the period in respect of which the charge has been paid,

"traffic sign" has the same meaning as in the Act,

"traffic warden" has the same meaning as defined by Part VIII of the Act,

"verge" means any part of a road which is not a carriageway and includes a footway.

PART II

For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying;

- (a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position if;
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle, or
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.
- (b) (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.

Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

<u>PART III</u>

PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING

- 1. (1) Save as provided in Article 5(a), (c), (e) and (f) no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload on any length of road or side or road;
 - (a) at any time as specified in Schedule 1.01 to this Order,
 - (b) between the hours of 8am and 7pm as specified in Schedule 1.02 to this Order,

- (c) between the hours of 10.30am to 4.30pm on Monday to Friday and 9am to 5pm on Saturday as specified in Schedule 1.03 to this Order.,
- (d) between the hours of 7.30am to 9.30am, 12.30pm to 2.30pm and 4.30pm to 6.30pm on Monday to Saturday, as specified in Schedule 1.04 to this Order,
- (e) between the hours of 7.30am to 9.30am and 4.30pm to 6.30pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 1.05 to this Order,
- (f) between the hours of 8.30 am to 9.30am and 4.30pm to 6.30pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 1.06 to this Order.
- (2) Save as provided in Article 5(a), (c), (f), (g), and (h) no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road or side or road specified in Schedule 10.01 between the hours of 7.30am to 9.30am and 4.30pm to 6.30pm on Monday to Friday.

PART IV

PROHIBITION OF WAITING

- (1) Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6a no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road or side of road;
 - (a) at any time as specified in Schedule 2.01 to this Order, or
 - (b) between the hours of 6am and midnight as specified in Schedule 2.03 to this Order when signs to diagram 636 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 are displayed, or
 - (c) between the hours of 8am and 9pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 3.01 to this Order, or
 - (d) between the hours of 8am and 7pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 3.02 to this Order, or
 - (e) between the hours of 8am and 6pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 3.03 to this Order, or
 - (f) between the hours of 8am and 5pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 3.04 to this Order, or
 - (g) between the hours of 7am and 7pm on Monday to Friday as specified in Schedule 3.05 to this Order, or
 - (h) between the hours of 8am and 5pm on Monday to Friday as specified in Schedule 3.06 to this Order, or
 - (i) between the hours of 10am and 11 am on Monday to Friday as specified in Schedule 3.07 to this Order, or
 - (j) between the hours of 9am and 5pm on Monday to Friday as specified in Schedule 3.08 to this Order, or
 - (k) between the hours of 8am and 7pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday as specified in Schedule 3.09 to this Order, or
 - (I) between the hours of 8am and 7pm on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday as specified in Schedule 3.10 to this Order, or
 - (m) between 7.00pm Friday and 3.00am Saturday, and 7.00pm Saturday and 3.00am Sunday.

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- (2) Save as provided in Article 5(a), (c), (e), (g), and (h) no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle other than a taxi to wait on any length of road or side of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 11.01 during the times stated in Column 3 of Schedule 11.01.
- **3.** Save as provided in Article 5 no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle weighing 2 tonnes or more to wait on any length of road or side of road specified in Schedule 2.02 to this Order.

PART V

LIMITED WAITING

- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6(b) no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any length of road or side of road;
 - (a) for a period exceeding one hour, no return within one hour between 8am and 9pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 4.01 to this Order,
 - (b) for a period exceeding one hour, no return within one hour between 8am and 7pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 4.02 to this Order,
 - (c) for a period exceeding one hour, no return within one hour between 8am and 6pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 4.03 to this Order,
 - (d) for a period exceeding one hour, no return within 2 hours between 7am and 8pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 4.04 to this Order,
 - (e) for a period exceeding one hour, no return within 1 hour between 7am and 7pm on Monday to Friday as specified in Schedule 4.05 to this Order,
 - (f) for a period exceeding 30 minutes, no return within one hour between 8am and 9pm on all days as specified in Schedule 4.06 to this Order,
 - (g) for a period exceeding 30 minutes, no return within one hour between 8am and 7pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 4.07 to this Order,
 - (h) for a period exceeding 20 minutes, no return within one hour on all days as specified in Schedule 4.08 to this Order,
 - for a period exceeding 20 minutes, no return within one hour between 8am and 7pm on Monday to Saturday as specified in Schedule 4.09 to this Order,

Nothing in this Article shall apply to the driver and passenger of a vehicle who are administering healthcare to a resident in that road or neighbouring road during the period of waiting and that if called upon to do so will produce confirmation of care provided in conjunction with their employment for the period of waiting at that time.

PART VI

EXEMPTIONS TO WAITING RESTRICTIONS

- 5. Save as provided in Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 12, 14, 17 and 49 nothing shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedules therein for so long as may be necessary to enable;
 - (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle,
 - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle,
 - (c) the vehicle if it cannot reasonably be used for the such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following;
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations,

- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic,
- (iii) the maintenance, reconstruction or improvement of that road,
- (iv) the laying, erection or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any telecommunications system defined by the Telecommunications Act 1984,
- use in the service of a statutory undertaker, the Environment Agency or any public authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties,
- (vi) for police, fire, or ambulance purposes,
- (vii) use for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined by Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953, or
- (d) in connection with any wedding or funeral,
- (e) being a hackney carriage to wait upon an authorised taxi rank, or
- (f) to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in the provision of a local service within the meaning of the Transport Act 1985
- (g) owing to the driver of the vehicle being required to do so by law or in order to avoid an accident or if he is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control.
- (h) while the vehicle is being used by or on behalf of the Council in connection with the collection of refuse from commercial, or residential properties, or the collection of refuse from various refuse deposits in that area, or litter picking.
- **6.** Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge to wait;
 - (a) in the lengths of road specified in Schedules 2.01, 2.03, and 3.01 to 3.11 inclusive for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day), provided that the Disabled Person's Vehicle displays in the relevant position a parking Disc on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began.
 - (b) in the lengths of road specified in Schedules 4.01 to 4.09 inclusive, 8.02 and 9.02 at any time on any day.

PART VII

DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES

- 7. The roads and parts of roads specified Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 5.01 are authorised to be used for such class of vehicles, in such positions and during such times as are specified in relation to those lengths of road in the said Schedule 5.01.
- 8. Save as provided in Article 5(a),(c) and (g) no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a disabled persons' parking place authorised by Article 7 unless;
 - (a) it is of the class specified in Column 3 of Schedule 5.01,
 - (b) it displays a Disabled Persons' Badge in accordance with Part II (a) and (b) of this Order,
 - (c) it does not exceed the permitted length of waiting specified in Column 4 of Schedule 5.01,
 - (d) it is parked as specified in Column 5 of Schedule 5.01.

PART VIII

LOADING BAYS

9. (1) The parts of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 6.01 are authorised to be used for such class of vehicles, during such times and in such positions as are specified in relation to those lengths of road in the said Schedule 6.01.

(2) Save as provided in Article 5(a), (b) and (c), no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a loading bay designated by Article 9(1) above.

- **10.** A driver of a vehicle shall not permit a vehicle to wait in a loading bay authorised by Schedule 6.01 unless;
 - (a) it is of the class specified in Column 3 of Schedule 6.01,
 - (b) it does not exceed the permitted length of waiting specified in Column 4 of Schedule 6.01, and
 - (c) it is parked as specified in Column 5 of Schedule 6.01.

PART IX

PARKING PLACES FOR SPECIFIED CLASSES OF VEHICLES

- **11.** The parts of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 7.01 are authorised to be used for such class of vehicles, in such positions and during such times as are specified in relation to those lengths of road in the said Schedule 7.01.
- 12. Save as provided in Article 5 no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a parking place authorised by Article 11 unless;
 - (a) it is of a class specified in Column 2 of Schedule 7.01, and
 - (c) it does not exceed the permitted length of waiting specified in Column 3 of Schedule 7.01.

<u>PART X</u>

PARKING PLACES FOR SOLO MOTORCYCLES

- **13.** The roads and parts of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 7.02 are authorised to be used as parking places for solo motorcycles in such positions and during such times as are specified in relation to those lengths of road in the said Schedule 7.02.
- **14.** Save as provided in Article 5(a), (b), (c), (g) and (h) no person shall except with the permission or direction of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a parking place authorised by Article 13 unless;
 - (a) it is of the class specified in Column 3 of Schedule 7.02; and
 - (b) does not exceed the permitted length of waiting specified in Column 4 of Schedule 7.02; and
 - (c) it is parked as specified in Column 5 of Schedule 7.02.

<u>PART XI</u>

AUTHORISATION OF RESIDENTS' PARKING PLACES

15. Each area on a highway which is described as a designated parking place in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 to this Order is designated as a parking place for resident permit holders.

- **16.** (1) A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place so as to unreasonably prevent access to any premises adjoining the road or the use of the road by any person or as to be a nuisance.
 - (2) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the Vehicle (Excise) Act 1971 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance that complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
 - (3) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change position of the vehicle in or depart from the parking place.
 - (4) (a) No person shall use a vehicle, whilst it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.

(b) No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place:-

(i) for sleeping or camping or cooking; or

(ii) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.

- (5) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or depart from the parking place.
- (6) Nothing in Article 15 shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the street, by Order, on the occasion of any public procession, carnival, or other similar activity, or where the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking place.
- (7) (a) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other that as specified in column 4 of Schedule 8.02 a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said specifications.

(b) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Article a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal.

(c) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council, or a Police Constable in uniform, or a Traffic Warden, or a Parking Attendant may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place, or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.

(d) Any person altering, or causing the alteration of the position of a vehicle by virtue of sub-paragraph (7)(a) of this Article, or removing, or causing the removal of a vehicle by virtue of sub-paragraphs (7)(b) or (7)(c) of this Article, may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed.

(e) Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of subparagraphs (7)(b) or (7)(c) of this Article shall make such arrangements as he considers to be reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed.

17. (1) Save as provided in Article 5 and 6(b) no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, Traffic Warden or of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any designated parking place specified in Schedule 8.02.

(2) Nothing in this Article shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a parking place during the permitted hours specified in column 5 of Schedule 8.02, provided that the vehicle displays at all times on the front near side of the vehicle a valid residents' permit issued or allocated in respect of that vehicle so that all the particulars referred to in Article 21 of the Order are readily visible from the front near side of the vehicle.

CONDITIONS OF A RESIDENT PERMIT

- 18. (1) The roads and lengths of roads specified in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 may be used by resident permit holders of the corresponding Zone as specified in Column 1 of that Schedule for the parking of a vehicle, or vehicles in such position as indicated in Column 4 of that Schedule and during such times of operation as are indicated in Column 5 of that Schedule, provided that a valid residents' permit is displayed on the said vehicle or vehicles in accordance with Article 17(2) of this Order.
 - (2) Any resident who is the owner of a vehicle of one of the following classes that is to say a passenger vehicle, a goods vehicle not exceeding 1524 kilograms un-laden weight or a motor cycle, may apply to the Council for the issue of a permit for the leaving of such vehicle and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be accompanied by a remittance for the charge specified in Article 22 (1) of this Order in respect of the permit for which application is being made.
 - (3) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a permit or a permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in respect of an application for a permit made to them as they reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any permit issued by them as they may reasonably require to verify that the permit is valid.
 - (4) On receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article, and of the fee specified in Article 22 (1) of this Order, the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident, and is the owner of the specified vehicle shall issue to the applicant one permit for the leaving of the specified vehicle during the permitted hours in a parking place to which such permit relates or to which such permit has been for the time being allocated by the owner of such vehicles or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward, provided that a permit shall not be issued if as a result there would be at any time more than two permits in force in respect of the same rateable residential premises.
 - (5) Any resident to whom hardship may be caused if no such permit is issued, may apply to the Council for the issue of a permit, which may be allocated to any vehicle of one of the following classes (that is to say a passenger vehicle, a goods vehicle not exceeding 1524 kilograms un-laden weight or a motor cycle) which for the period of such allocation is being left by the driver thereof in order to visit that resident's home. Any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtained from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be accompanied by a remittance for the charge specified in Article 22(1) of this Order in respect of the permit for which application is being made.
- (6) The roads listed in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 to this Order are divided into Zones as indicated in Column 1 of that Schedule and a permit issued will only entitle that permit holder to park in the lengths of road which are in the same Zone as the resident's address as specified in column 2 of Schedule 8.01 hereto.
- A permit allocated to a vehicle under paragraph (5) of this Article may only be displayed on that vehicle while it is left in one of the lengths of road listed in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 hereto which is in the same Zone as the resident's address to whom the permit has been issued and is specified in column 2 of Schedule 8.01.
- **19.** (1) A permit holder may surrender a permit to the Council at any time and in any case shall surrender a permit to the Council on the occurrence of any one, or more of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article.

- (2) The Council may, by notice in writing served on the permit holder by sending the same by recorded delivery service or by hand delivery to the permit holders address shown by that person on the application for the permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a permit if it appears to the Council that any one or more of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article has occurred and the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council no later than 4 days after sending by post or hand delivery of such notice.
- (3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:
 - (a) the permit holder ceasing to be a resident;
 - (b) the permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued;
 - (c) the vehicle in respect of which such permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class specified in Article 18(2) of this Order;
 - (d) The permit ceasing to be valid owing to the cessation of the cause of hardship through which the permit has been issued under Article 18(5) above;
 - (e) When a permit is issued to any person upon receipt of a cheque and the cheque is subsequently dishonoured.
- (4) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article, a permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified thereon or on the occurrence of any one, or more of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article, whichever is the earlier.
- **20.** (1) If a permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council or apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate permit and the Council upon receipt of the permit, shall issue a duplicate permit so marked and upon such issue the original permit shall become invalid.
 - (2) If a permit is lost, stolen or destroyed, the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate permit and the Council, upon being satisfied as to such loss, theft or destruction, shall issue a duplicate permit so marked and upon such issue the original permit shall become invalid. Any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtained from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be accompanied by a remittance for the charge specified in Article 22(2) of this Order in respect of the permit for which application is being made.
 - (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate permit and an application therefore as if it were a permit or as the case may be an application therefore.
- 21. A permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
 - (a) The registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which the permit has been issued or in the case of a permit issued under Article 18(5) of this Order, the words 'Visitor's Permit' and the name and address of the resident to whom the permit has been issued.
 - (b) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 19(4) of this Order, the permit shall remain valid.
 - (c) An indication that the permit has been issued by the Council.
 - (d) The zone to which the permit relates.
- 22. (1) The charge in connection with the issue of a permit as specified in Article 18 and for the leaving of a vehicle in any parking place during the permitted hours shall be £12 for any period of twelve months running from the beginning of the month in which the permit first became valid. This remittance shall be subject to an annual increment of

£2. This will be implemented on 1st April 2003 and every year thereafter on the 1st April.

- (2) The charge in connection with the issue of a permit as specified in Article 20(2) and for the leaving of a vehicle in any parking place during the permitted hours shall be £5.
- (3) All charges made in respect of a permit are non-refundable.
- **23.** Where a permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 17(2) of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the permit from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

<u>PART XII</u>

CONDITIONS OF WAITING IN A PARKING PLACE

24. (1) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 17(2) of this Order the following vehicles may be left during the permitted hours in a parking place and any such vehicle shall be exempt from the payment of any charge specified in this Order;

a vehicle being left by the driver thereof, who is a person who on the account of his or her, or his or her passenger's severe physical disability has been issued with an invalid carriage or vehicle and a disabled persons badge and parking disc and with the badge and disc being displayed on the vehicle in accordance with Part II of this Order may wait in any of the lengths of roads or sides of roads specified in columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 to this Order.

- (2) Without prejudice to the generality of this Article, a vehicle to which this Article applies shall stand in the parking space in accordance with the provisions of Article 26 and Schedule 8.02 of this Order and wholly within the limits of that space.
- 25. Save as provided in Article 31 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden or of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a road or length or road specified in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 8.02 for a longer period than stated in Column 5 of Schedule 8.02 or, where applicable, to return to that road or length of road within the prohibited period stated in Column 5.
- **26.** Subject to the provisions of Article 16 the driver of a vehicle waiting in a designated parking place or space during the permitted hours in accordance with the foregoing provisions and those specified in Schedules 5.01,6.01, 7.01, 7.02, 8.02 and 9.01to this Order shall so cause it to stand so that:
 - (a) if the parking place is not in a one-way street, that the left or near side of the vehicle is adjacent to the left hand edge of the carriageway, unless otherwise indicated in the relevant Schedule;
 - (b) that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres when the vehicle is required by the relevant Schedule to park parallel with the kerb;
 - (c) that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking place; and
 - (d) that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting.
- 27. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place or space in contravention of the provisions of the last preceding Articles or of the provisions of Article 24 of this Order, a police constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden or of a Parking Attendant may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.
- **28.** A police constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden or a Parking Attendant may move or cause to be moved, in case of emergency, to any place he thinks fit, any vehicle left in a parking place.
- **29.** (1) Any person duly authorised by the Council or by the Chief Officer of Thames Valley Police may suspend the use of a restricted road or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
- (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to that length of restricted road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway or the cleansing of gullies in or adjacent to the parking place, the laying erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of restricted road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign;
- (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to that length of restricted road on any occasion of the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwelling house;
- (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed;
- (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to that length of restricted road at the times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions.
- (2) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than 24 hours the use of that length of restricted road or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- (3) On the suspension of the use of that length of restricted road or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of this Article the person authorised or causing such suspension shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that length of restricted road or that part thereof as the case may be, traffic signs indicating that the waiting of vehicles is prohibited.
- (4) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in that length of restricted road or part thereof during such period as there is in or adjacent to that length of restricted road or that part thereof a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (3) of this Article, provided that nothing in this paragraph shall apply:
 - in respect of any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle which is waiting for any reason specified in Article 31(b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (i) or (j); or
 - (b) to anything done with the permission of the person suspending the use of that length of restricted road or part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this Article.
- **30.** No person shall use any parking place or any vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of any goods to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of his skill in handicraft or his services in any other capacity provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle:
 - (a) when the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected; or
 - (b) if the vehicle is one to which the provisions of Article 31(k) or (l) apply.
- **31.** Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order with respect to vehicles left in a parking place/space in accordance with those provisions, any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours anywhere in a parking place in a parking space, other than a parking place/space or part of a parking place/space the use of which has been suspended;
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in conjunction with any of the following operations, namely:

- (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads or side of roads; or
- (iv) the laying, erecting, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of roads or side of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system.
- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of the Council, a sewer, gas, water or electricity authority or telecommunication operator in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) while the vehicle is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- while the vehicle is being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
- (f) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road or sides of roads for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral or for the removal of furniture to or from offices or dwelling houses on or adjacent to the said length of roads;
- (g) to enable the vehicle being left by the driver thereof displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, to wait for a period not exceeding 3 hours such period not being separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the road on the same day save that this paragraph does not apply in respect of a bus lane at a time when the bus lane is in operation.
- (h) to cause or permit a vehicle being a hackney carriage to wait upon an authorised cab rank.
- (i) owing to the driver of the vehicle being required to do so by law or in order to avoid an accident or if he is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control.
- (j) while the vehicle is left or is being used by or on behalf of the Council in connection with the collection of refuse from commercial or residential properties or the collection of refuse from various refuse deposits in that area or litter picking.
- (k) the vehicle is waiting otherwise than in a parking place/space if goods are being sold or offered for sale from the vehicle by a person who is licensed by the Council to sell goods from a stationary pitch situated in the parking place or space;
- (I) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable it to be used in connection with posting or removing advertising material in the form of posters on or from, or cleaning windows or chimneys, in premises adjacent to the parking place/space in which the vehicle is waiting; or
- (m) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise, including, so far as a bank is concerned, cash or other valuables or valuable securities, or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place/space in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle not being a goods vehicle does not wait for such purpose for more than thirty minutes or for such longer period as a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden may authorise, or, being a goods vehicle does not so wait for more than thirty minutes or such longer period as aforesaid if it is in any part of a parking place/space.
- (n) to enable the driver and passenger of a vehicle to administer healthcare to a resident in that road or neighbouring road during the period of waiting and that if called upon to do so will produce confirmation of care provided in conjunction with their employment for the period of waiting at that time.

32. A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking place or space by virtue of the provisions of Article 31(b),(e),(f),(k),(l), or (m) of this Order shall ensure that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than twelve inches (300 mm), unless otherwise specified in the relevant Schedule.

<u>PART XIII</u>

PAY & DISPLAY

- **33.** The lengths of road or sides of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 9.02 of this Order are designated as on-street Pay & Display parking places for the waiting of vehicles in the position indicated in Column 3 of the said Schedule 9.02.
- **34.** (a) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any parking place designated in Schedule 9.02 to this Order on the controlled days stated in Column 4 of Schedule 9.02 and during the controlled hours stated in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02 to this Order unless a provision of Article 36 below applies to the vehicle.
 - (b) Where a vehicle waits in any parking place designated in Schedule 9.02 of this Order on the controlled days and during the controlled hours other than in compliance with the remaining provisions of this Order a penalty charge shall become payable.
 - (c) A penalty charge notice giving the prescribed information, the amount of penalty charge and reduced penalty charge payable may be either fixed to the vehicle or given to a person appearing to be in charge of the vehicle by a parking attendant in accordance with the 1991 Act.
- **35.** "conditions of waiting" means as specified in Articles 36 and 37, and in columns 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 9.02 of this Order.

"controlled days" means the days of the week specified in Column 4 of Schedule 9.02 to this Order as being the days of the week when restrictions imposed by Article 34 of this Order are effective.

"controlled hours" means the hours specified in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02 to this Order as being the hours of the day when the restrictions imposed by Article 34 are effective.

CONDITIONS OF WAITING

- **36.** (a) Any person may cause or permit a vehicle which displays a valid parking ticket issued under the following provisions of this Order at the commencement of a period of permitted waiting, to wait in any of the parking places designated by this Order as parking places for that purpose. The same are more particularly identified by an indication to the effect that ticket parking is permitted and the duration of permitted parking as specified in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02 to this Order by which such waiting is permitted.
 - (b) Any person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the parking places designated in Schedule 9.02 to this Order shall on the expiry of the time for which a parking ticket has been purchased cause that vehicle to be taken away from that parking place.
 - (c) Any permission conferred by paragraph (a) above is subject to the limitation that no vehicle which is taken away from a parking place shall return to that parking place until the period stated in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02 shall have elapsed during the controlled hours.
 - (d) Save as provided in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02, any person may cause or permit a vehicle which displays a valid residents' permit issued in accordance with the provisions of Articles 18 of this Order to wait without charge in a parking place within the Zone to which the permit applies.
 - (e) Any person may cause or permit a vehicle which displays a disabled person's badge and parking disc in accordance with Part II of this Order to wait in any parking place designated by Article 33 of this Order.

- (f) Save as provided in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02, any person may cause or permit a vehicle which displays a residents' visitor permit in accordance with the remaining provisions of this Order to wait in any parking place within the Zone to which that permit applies.
- (g) Any person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait without charge in any of the parking places designated by Schedule 33 to this Order if:
 - the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic or,
 - (ii) the vehicle is being used by or with the consent of Slough Borough Council and whilst being so used it is necessary for it to wait in that parking place or,
 - (iii) the person in charge of the vehicle is required by law to stop or is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or,
 - (iv) the vehicle is being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service for operational purposes or,
 - (v) the permission of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden or parking attendant is given for the vehicle to wait or,
 - (vi) the vehicle is being used for the collection or delivery of postal packets as defined by Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953 or,
 - (vii) the vehicle is waiting for as long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or,
 - (viii) goods are being loaded or unloaded from the vehicle without interval.
- **37.** Except as otherwise provided by Article 36 above, no person may cause or permit a heavy goods vehicle or a bus to wait in any of the parking places designated by this Order.

DISPLAY OF PAY & DISPLAY PARKING TICKETS

- **38.** (a) A parking device or parking ticket is valid when it is displayed on a vehicle and the details in paragraph (e) below are legible from the front or nearside of the vehicle and the device or parking ticket has not been altered or defaced.
 - (b) Where a parking ticket is displayed in accordance with paragraph (a) above it is valid until the time of expiry indicated thereon.
 - (c) Notwithstanding the remaining provisions of this Order no person shall display a parking ticket on a vehicle where a parking ticket has previously been displayed on that vehicle in that parking place, until the period stated in Column 5 of Schedule 9.02 shall have elapsed since that vehicle left that parking place.
 - (d) Nothing in this Article confers permission to wait upon a vehicle of a class prohibited by Article 37 above.
 - (e) The details referred to in paragraph (a) above are:
 - (i) the date of issue,
 - (ii) serial number if any,
 - (iii) the time of purchase of the parking device or parking ticket where applicable,
 - (iv) the time of expiry and the amount paid thereof.

DESIGNATION OF AND PAYMENT AT PAY & DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

Each area of highway whether or not wholly comprised in a carriageway, footway or

- Nothing in this Article confers permission for a vehicle to contravene the remaining provisions of this Order and in particular Articles 42, 43 and 44.
- Where a parking place is suspended in whole or in part in accordance with the provisions of Article 29, the person for whose benefit the parking place is suspended shall be liable to a charge the scale of which will be approved by the Council from time to time.

PAYMENT OF PAY & DISPLAY PARKING CHARGES

- 40. A parking charge shall become payable upon the leaving of a vehicle in a parking place referred to in Article 33 above and where a charge is specified shall be payable by the insertion in a ticket machine relating to that parking place of any combination of coins of the following denominations: 10 pence, 20 pence, 50 pence, 1 pound, or 2 pounds and where more than one coin is required for payment of that parking charge the coins shall be inserted one following another in the ticket machine or such other method of payment as the Council may from time to time authorise.
 - A parking ticket shall be displayed in accordance with Article 38 above. (b)
 - (c) Where a vehicle is left in a parking place designated by this Order as a ticket parking place beyond the expiry of the time indicated on a ticket during the controlled hours a Penalty Charge Notice shall be payable and may be affixed to the vehicle or given to a person appearing to be in charge of that vehicle.
 - (d) For the avoidance of doubt, the limit of waiting time applicable to a parking place shall take precedence over the times shown on a parking ticket or parking device in determining whether a Penalty Charge Notice is payable.
- 41. (1)Where a vehicle is left in or is using a parking place referred to Schedule 9.02 during the operational hours in contravention of this Order and additional amount, hereinafter referred to as the "penalty charge" shall become payable.
 - (2)In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge has been incurred, a parking attendant may attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position, or at his discretion, hand to a person whom he has reason to believe has incurred the penalty charge under this Order a notice which shall include the following particulars:-
 - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the general registration mark assigned to the holder of that licence and which mark is shown on the trade plates carried by that vehicle;
 - (b) the time by which he had reason to believe that a penalty charge has been incurred:
 - a statement that a penalty charge is required to be paid; (c)
 - the manner in which, and the time within which the penalty charge should be (d) paid.
 - Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the (3)provisions of Article 41, no person, not being the owner or person in charge of a vehicle or a parking attendant, shall remove the notice from a vehicle unless authorised to do so by the said persons, provided that nothing herein shall apply to a

parking attendant or a person removing a vehicle in pursuance to Articles 16(7) or 43(1).

- (4) The penalty charge shall be payable to the Council as described in Article 44 of this Order.
- **42.** (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 31, where a parking attendant is of the opinion that the provisions of this Order have been contravened in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall provide safe custody of the vehicle; and
 - (2) the Council may retain custody of the vehicle so removed from the parking place until such time as-
 - (a) the expenses incurred by the Council in removing and storing that vehicle; and
 - (b) the outstanding charges in respect of that vehicle have been paid in full;

provided that any such vehicle shall only be released from custody of the Council on production of the written authority of the registered keeper of that vehicle.

SPECIAL USE OF PAY & DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

- **43.** (a) The Council or an Officer authorised by the Council to do so may authorise the use of a parking place for any purpose in whole or part on the application of any person and shall take into account Section 122 of the Act.
 - (b) Any such authorisation may be issued subject to conditions including the charge if any payable for that authorisation in respect of the particular use of that parking place by the applicant.
 - (c) Any application shall be in writing and shall contain sufficient information to enable the Council to identify the parking place and determine whether any condition should be imposed including the duration of authorisation.
 - (d) A police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a parking attendant may suspend the use of a parking place in whole or part for a period not exceeding 7 days.
 - (c) Any person authorised by paragraph (a) above may suspend the use of a parking place in whole or part for a period not exceeding 28 days or such longer period as may be authorised in writing.

MISCELLANEOUS

44. (1) Where a vehicle contravenes any provision of this Order a Penalty Charge Notice giving the information required by the 1991 Act (as amended) and stating the prescribed amount payable as a penalty charge and the amount of the reduced penalty charge payable may be fixed to a vehicle or given to a person appearing to be in charge of a vehicle by a Parking Attendant in accordance with the 1991 Act (as amended).

(2) A penalty charge shall be paid to the Council by such means of payment as may be approved by the Council and which shall be delivered or sent to the address, or addresses shown on the penalty charge notice and in accordance with the instructions on that notice to arrive not later than 4.30pm on;

- (a) the 14th day after the date shown on the penalty charge notice as being the date of issue of the notice in which case a reduced penalty charge as indicated on the notice shall be payable or;
- (b) the 28th day after the date shown on the penalty charge notice as being the date of issue of the notice.
- (3) Provided that the aforesaid 14th or 28th day fall upon a day which the Offices at the address or addresses given are not open for the receipt of payment then the date by which the penalty charge or reduced penalty charge shall be payable shall be deemed

to be extended until 4.30pm of the next following day upon which the said Offices are open for the receipt of such payments.

- **45.** A person who causes or permits a vehicle, any trailer or any vehicle and trailer to be left otherwise than wholly within the marked area of a designated parking place contravenes this Order and a Penalty Charge Notice may be affixed to the vehicle, trailer, or given to any person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle or trailer.
- **46.** No person shall use a vehicle whilst it is waiting in a designated parking place for, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of goods or services unless that person has obtained the written consent of the Council before doing so.
- **47.** For the purpose of the charges specified in Article 39(b) above, the parking charges in respect of a vehicle left in a Pay and Display parking place defined by virtue of that paragraph shall be either the charge stated in the relevant Schedule, or as the case may be from time to time varied by Notice.

PART X1V

BUS STOP CLEARWAYS

- **48.** Save as provided in Article 5(c), (f), (g) and (h) no person shall except upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform, traffic warden, or parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus to stop;
 - (a) at any time on any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 12.01, and
 - (b) between the hours of 7.00am and 7.00pm on any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 12.02.

PART XV

FURTHER PROVISIONS AS TO INTERPRETATION

- **49.** A vehicle is to be regarded as engaged on emergency service if it is being used by or on behalf of a person who is;
 - (a) undertaking emergency works with a view to preventing injury to any person or serious loss or damage to property in the vicinity of the parking place, or
 - (b) responding to an emergency situation he reasonably believes to be occurring and that person removes the vehicle from the parking place as soon as is practicable.
