
- The Council of the Borough of Slough, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Sections 1, 2, 4, 124 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-
- 2. This Order shall come into effect on the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2007 and may be cited as "The Borough of Slough Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2006 (Amendment No. 9) Order 2007.
- 3. The Borough of Slough Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2006 shall have effect as though:
  - (a) Schedule 2.01 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule A to this Order
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Lammas Road	North-west and north sides: From its junction with Burnham Lane north-eastwards and eastwards for a distance of 54 metres
	South-east and south sides :  (i) from its junction with Burnham Lane north-eastwards for a distance of 14 metres
	(ii) from a point 39 metres north-east of its junction with Burnham Lane north-eastwards and eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order is being introduced following complaints from residents of obstructive and dangerous parking in close proximity to the junction with Burnham Lane and the sharp bend to the east of that junction.
