

THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH
WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS' PARKING ORDER 2006
(AMENDMENT No. 12) Order 2007

1. The Council of the Borough of Slough, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Sections 1, 2, 4, 124 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order :-
2. This Order shall come into effect on the 26th November 2007 and may be cited as "The Borough of Slough Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2006 (Amendment No. 12) Order 2007."
3. The Borough of Slough Waiting Restrictions and Residents' Parking Order 2006 shall have effect as though :
 - (a) Schedule 3.01 was amended by the deletion of the wording in Schedule A to this Order;
 - (b) Schedule 3.01 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule B to this Order;
 - (c) Schedule 2.01 was amended by the deletion of the wording in Schedule C to this Order;

 - (e) Schedule 9.02 was amended by the deletion of the wording in Schedule E to this Order;
 - (f) Schedule 9.02 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule F to this Order;
 - (g) Schedule 8.01 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule G to this Order;
 - (h) Schedule 8.02 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule H to this Order;
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

**THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS'
PARKING ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT No. 12) ORDER 2007**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order introduces shared use pay and display/resident permit parking into Wexham Road. This will provide a parking facility for both local workers, visitors and residents. The order deletes old definitions for pay and display bays which were never introduced on-street.

It is also proposed to prohibit waiting at all times along the remaining lengths of the west side of Wexham Road in the interests of road safety, to maintain sight-lines at junctions and to assist with the free flow of through traffic. The existing single yellow line on the south-east side is to remain.

It is also proposed to remove the pay and display charges from the bay in the lay-by north of Mirador Crescent as these are no longer required. The lay-by will revert to free parking.
