(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) ORDER 2005

(AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2008

The Council of the Borough of Slough, in exercise of the powers conferred under sections 1, 2, 4, 9, 10 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order :

1. This Order shall come into operation on 14th April 2008 and may be cited as Borough of Slough (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2005 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2008.

2. The Borough of Slough (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Order 2005 shall have effect as though :

(a) The following definitions are added to the Order :

“Civil Enforcement Officer” has the same meaning as that given in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

“penalty charge” has the same meaning as that given in section 92 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

“penalty charge notice” means a notice showing the information required by the Schedule of The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.

(b) Article 3 was replaced by the following Article :

3. Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall, except upon permission of a police officer in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order between the hours of 8am and 5pm Monday to Friday.

(c) The following Articles are added to the Order :

6. If a vehicle is stopped or parked on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order then a penalty charge shall be payable.

7. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council by such method deemed appropriate by the Council in accordance with the instructions on the penalty charge notice.

3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

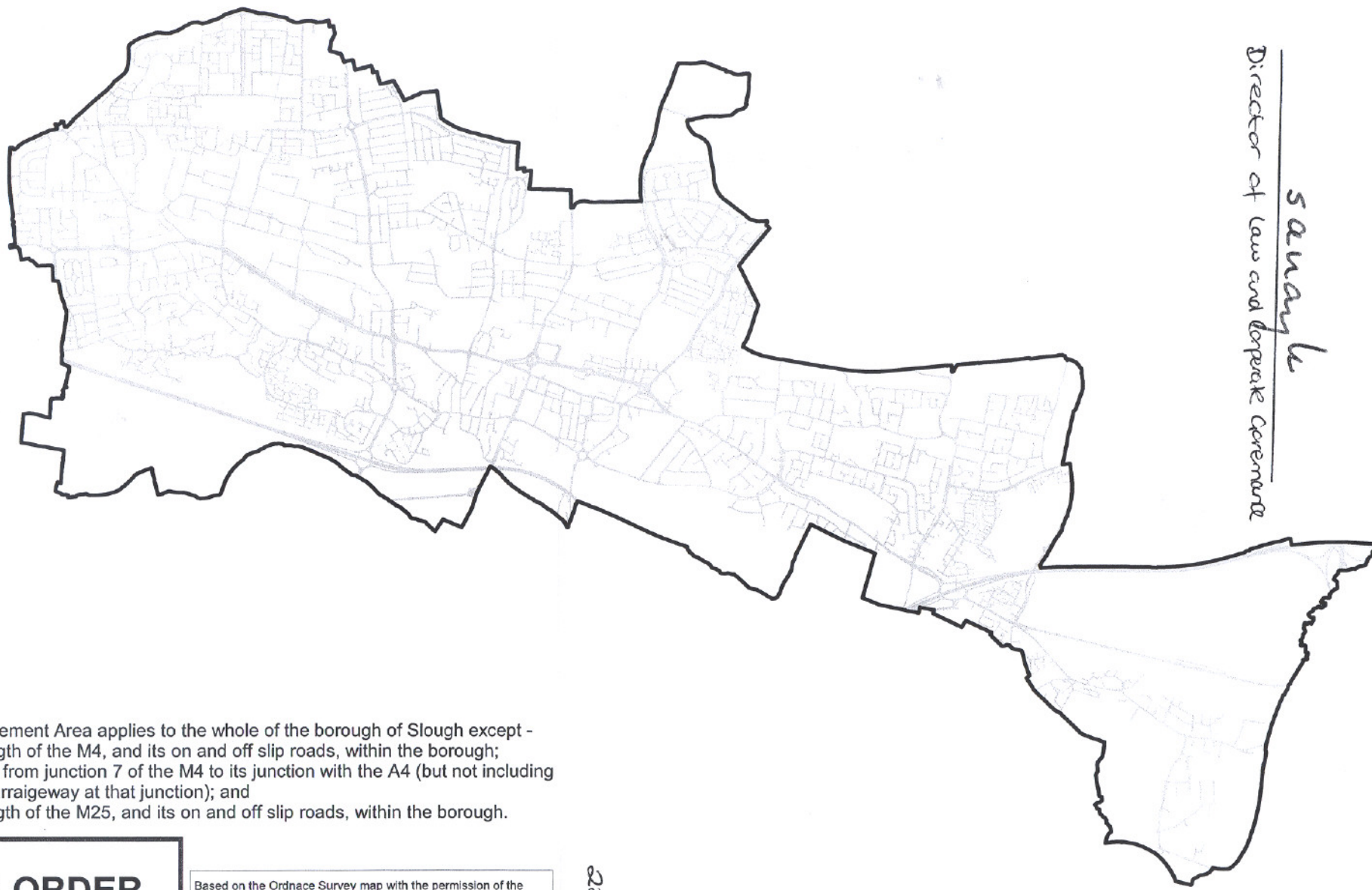
STATEMENT OF REASONS

(a) the entire length of the M4, and its on and off slip roads, within the borough;
(b) the spur road from junction 7 of the M4 to its junction with the A4 (but not including the circulatory carriageway at that junction); and
(c) the entire length of the M25, and its on and off slip roads, within the borough.
