 - (b) The items relating to Farnham Road and Pitts Road were deleted from Schedule 3.02 of that Order;
 - (c) Schedule 3.02 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule B to this Order;
 - (d) Schedule 3.03 was amended by the addition of the wording in Schedule C to this Order; and
 - (e) Schedule 4.10 is added to that Order by the addition of the wording in Schedule D to this Order.
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order introduces 'No waiting at any time' restrictions to prevent obstructive parking either side of the road closure in Pitts Road and to improve sightlines outside No. 34.

Existing single yellow line waiting restrictions on the northern side of Pitts Road will be amended to operate between 8am and 6pm Monday to Saturday and a limited stay parking bay 'Maximum stay 2 hours no return within one hour' between 8am and 6pm Monday to Saturday will be introduced on the south side of Pitts Road outside the Church.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of this experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely.

BOROUGH OF SLOUGH (PITTS ROAD)(ROAD CLOSURE) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2008.

The Council of the Borough of Slough has made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which is to introduce a road closure in Pitts Road outside No. 46.

The Order was made on the 28th November 2008 and will come into operation on the 8th December 2008 for a maximum period of eighteen months.



Within a period of six months from 8th December 2008 (or if the Order is subsequently varied by another order under section 9 of the Act or modified pursuant to subsection (2) of section 10 to the Act, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification, whichever is the latest) any person may object to the making of the Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation. Any such objection should be sent in writing, stating the grounds for making them, to the undersigned.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, can do so, within six weeks of the 28th November 2008 by applying to the High Court.

- 2. Pitts Road will be closed at the point outside No. 46 Pitts Road and as a consequence of that closure no person shall permit any vehicle to travel the length of Pitts Road between its junction with the A355 Farnham Road and the A4 Bath Road as specified in the attached Schedule.
- 3. The prohibition referred to in Paragraph 2 above will not apply to pedal cycles (not being motor vehicles) and emergency service vehicles.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
