STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order is being introduced as part of the Safer Routes to School scheme for Beechwood School. This traffic management scheme is designed to reduce vehicle speeds along Long Readings Lane whilst also improving access to the school for pedestrians and cyclists.

This Order amends existing waiting restrictions and introduces new restrictions as part of the scheme.
