STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH (AMENDMENT NO.19) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS' PARKING ORDER 2010) (EXPERIMENTAL) (ORDER 5 OF 2013)

Slough Borough Council is making the above experimental Traffic Regulation Order to improve access for HGV's and Emergency Service Vehicles using Waterside Drive. By sealing this order, parked vehicles will be done so in a staggered manor that allows easy access for large HGV's and Emergency Service Vehicles and restricts the ability for vehicles to be double parked. Being in close proximity to Langley Train Station, Pay and Display parking is offered to commuters with long term parking requirements as well as short stay visitors to the area. Parking charges will be in line with those at Langley Train Station.

The order is being made under an experimental order to trial these new restrictions, and also to allow changes to be made to the scheme if there are negative impacts on the surrounding roads.
