

**THE TAUNTON DEANE BOROUGH (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)**  
**(NO. 27 AMENDMENT) ORDER 2006**

The Taunton Deane Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 35 (1), (3) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Somerset County Council, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 3 April 2006 and may be cited as "The Taunton Deane Borough (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 27 Amendment) Order 2006."
2. Schedule 2 of The Taunton Deane Borough (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1985 shall be deleted in total and shall be replaced with the revised Schedule 2 attached herewith.

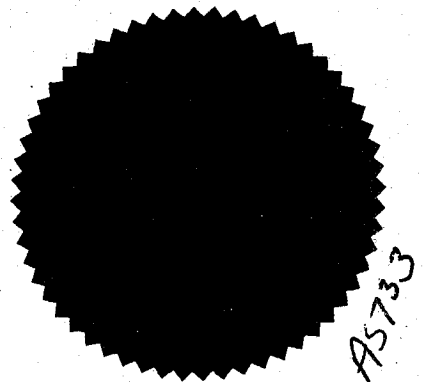
