

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL

(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (KINGS CHASE SHOPPING CENTRE CAR PARK) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2023

The South Gloucestershire District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

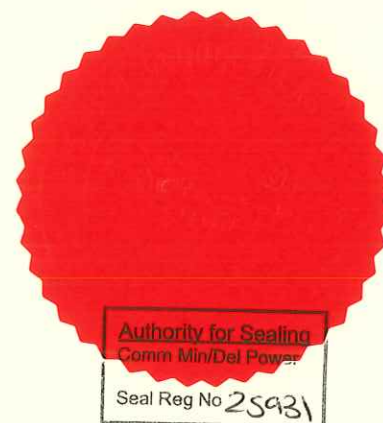
1. This order shall come into operation on the 20 July 2023 and may be cited as the South Gloucestershire Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Kings Chase Shopping Centre Car Park) (Variation No. 1) Order 2023.
2. The South Gloucestershire Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2022 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though:-
 - a) in Article 2. (2) thereof, there were inserted after the definition "**penalty charge notice**" and before the definition "**prescribed**", the additional definition "**permit**" as set out in Schedule 1 to this order, so as to maintain the items in alphabetical order;
 - b) there were inserted after article 4. (4) thereof, the article 4.(5) as set in in Schedule 2 to this order; and
 - c) in Schedule 1 thereto, there were inserted so as to maintain all items therein in alphabetical order of names of car parks, the additional car park namely **KINGS CHASE SHOPPING CENTRE** car park, as set out in Schedule 3 to this order.

- 2 (2) **“permit”** means an authorisation provided by South Gloucestershire Council to employees of retail premises situated in and around the Kings Chase Shopping Centre to allow extended parking in the Kings Chase Shopping Centre Car Park;

SCHEDULE 2

4. (5) the permit specified in column 6 of Schedule 1 relating to Kings Chase Shopping Centre Car Park is provided to employees of retail premises situated in and around the Kings Chase Shopping Centre for use in Kings Chase Shopping Centre Car Park only. A charge of £75 per annum applies to each and every permit supplied. The permit may only be used by employees of retail premises situated in and around the Kings Chase Shopping Centre.
