<u>DISTRICT OF SOUTH HAMS (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)</u> (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2001

SOUTH HAMS DISTRICT COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under sections 35 (1) (3) and (3A) and Paragraph 27 of the Ninth Schedule to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, with the consent of Devon County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of the Ninth Schedule to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 2002 and may be cited as the District of South Hams (Off-Street Parking Places)(Amendment) Order 2002.

2. Interpretation

Interpretation of this Order shall be as provided for in Article 2 of the District of South Hams (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1999 ("the Principal Order").

3. Amendment

The Principal Order shall be amended by:-

- the deletion of the Schedule thereto, and its substitution by the Schedule to this Order;
- (b) the extension of the parking restrictions in relation to the following Car Parks-
 - (i) Beesands
 - (ii) Dartmouth Castle
 - (iii) Dartmouth Market Square (no parking permitted on Tuesdays and Fridays)
 - (iv) Malborough
 - (v) Marldon

- (vi) South Brent (vii) Stoke Fleming (viii) Wembury (ix) Yealmpton (x) Hope Cove (xi) Dittisham
- (c) The addition of sub-clause 19(e) "play any ball games"
