THE SOUTH LAKELAND DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1993

The South Lakeland District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and all other enabling powers in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PART 1

GENERAL

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the Ninth day of April 1993 and may be cited as "The South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1993".
- 2. The South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1986, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1987, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1987, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1988, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1988, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1990, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1990, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1991, the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1991, and the South Lakeland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1992 are hereby revoked.
- 3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Contract Parking Ticket" means a ticket issued by the Council or the written permission of the Council authorising the parking of a designated vehicle upon a named parking place, subject to such conditions as may from time to time be fixed by the Council.

"Driver" in relation to a motor vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the motor vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place and in relation to a trailer, boat trailer, or other non-mechanically propelled vehicle, means the driver of the motor vehicle by which that trailer, boat trailer or other vehicle, is being drawn at the time of parking.

"Goods Vehicle" means a vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description other than a motor vehicle which falls within the definition of a motor car in Section 136 of the 1984 Act.

"Motor Car" and "Invalid Carriage" have the same meaning respectively as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act; the expression "motor car" shall include a motor cycle.

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle.

"Parking Place" means an area of land specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order and provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act as a parking place.

"Public Service Vehicle" means a vehicle constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects.

"Relevant Position" means, in relation to Articles 7(3) and 7(4) of this Order.

- (a) on the inside of the front windscreen with the obverse side of the ticket facing forwards;
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen any conspicuous position on the vehicle.

"Vehicle". includes a motor vehicle, a non-mechanically propelled vehicle, trailer or boat trailer.

PART II

· USE OF PARKING PLACES

- Each area of land specified by name in the Schedule to this Order may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles, in such positions and on such days and during such hours and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to that area in the said Schedule.
 - (1) Where in the Schedule to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place:-
 - (a) unless it is of the specified class; or
 - (b) in a position other than that specified.
 - (2) The Council may, by appropriate markings or signs, indicate sections of a parking place which are reserved for particular classes of vehicle and, in those cases, vehicles of these particular classes only may be parked in the section so indicated.
- 6. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in the Schedule to this Order in relation to that parking place.
- 7. (1) (a) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall, on leaving the vehicle in the parking place, pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the Scale of Charges specified in Column 7 of the Schedule to this Order, provided that no charge shall be payable by the driver of a vehicle left in that parking place who produces a valid season ticket issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (4) of this Article.

the case of a motor vehicle to which a trailer is tracked, the driver shall purchase two tickets and display them in the relevant position on the motor vehicle.

- (c) In the case of a coach the driver shall purchase six tickets and display them in the relevant position on the coach.
- (2) The charge referred to in the last preceding paragraph shall be payable
 - (a) by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the apparatus or device provided, being an apparatus or device having been specially or generally approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment for such purpose; or
 - .(b) to the Council's duly authorised agent at the parking place.
- (3) Any ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article shall be attached in a relevant position to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued and shall be exhibited in that position at all times while the vehicle is parked in the parking place.
- (4) The owner of a vehicle may, on application to the Council, purchase a season ticket in respect of that vehicle and, provided that it is displayed in a relevant position, that season ticket shall be valid in such parking places as are specified thereon during the period for which it is issued.
- 8. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking space and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 9. No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services without the written consent of the Council.
- 10. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 5, 6, 7(1) or 7(3), or Article 11 of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place and the Council shall be entitled to recover from any person responsible such charges as may be prescribed, provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 5(b) of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 11. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971, or any statutory amendment thereof and, unless there is, in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver, such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988, or any statutory amendment thereof.

more driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, drive any vehicle in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.

- 14. No person shall in a parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.
- 15. No person shall in a parking place
 - (1) use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned;
 - (2) damage or interfere with the fabric, structures, apparatus or equipment of any parking place.
- 16. No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place for sleeping or camping purposes.
- 17. No person shall use any part of a parking place for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.
- 18. No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another road.
- 19. In a parking place no person shall:-
 - (a) transfer an unexpired ticket from one vehicle to another;

- (b) remove a parking ticket or a season ticket, exhibited in accordance with Article 7(3) or 7(4) of this Order, until the vehicle is about to be removed from the parking place; or
- (c) permit any vehicle drawn by another vehicle to wait in a parking place unless it remains attached to the drawing vehicle and unless the vehicle drawn displays the identity of the person responsible for it;
- (2) (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council;
 - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire or cooking apparatus which utilises a naked flame; or
 - (c) leave any litter other than in a litter bin provided by the Council.

- The following vehicles left in a parking place shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from the payment of any charge specified in Column 6 or 7, as the case may be, of the Schedule to this Order:-
 - (1) an invalid carriage;
 - (2) a vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Department of Health and Social Services in lieu of an invalid carriage;
 - (3) a vehicle left by the driver thereof, who is a person who, on account of his severe physical disability, has been given a notice in writing by the Council that he is exempt from any such charge or limitation on time, if the notice is displayed on the vehicle in a conspicuous position; and
 - (4) a disabled person's vehicle which displays, in the relevant position, a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge.
- 21. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 10 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.
- 22. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 10 of this Order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- 23. The Council may, at any time, without giving prior notice, close the whole or any part of a parking place for use by vehicles of all or any class and may, at any time, by notice posted on the parking place, waive the appropriate charge over all or any part of a parking place,
- 24. If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 5, 6, (7(1)) (7(3), 9, 11, 16 or 17 of this Order, the driver of the vehicle shall pay an excess charge of £50.00 within 14 days of the date on which notice of the excess charge is issued, provided that, if within seven days of the said date, the driver tenders the sum of £25.00 then this latter sum may be accepted by the Council in satisfaction of the excess charge.
- 25. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which an excess charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of a parking attendant to attach to the vehicle, in a conspicuous position, a notice which shall include the following particulars:-
 - (1) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle, or in the case of a trailer, boat trailer or other vehicle, the registration mark of the vehicle drawing it;
 - (2) the time at which he first noticed the contravention;
 - (3) the nature of the contravention;

- (4) a statement that an excess charge is required to be paid in accordance with Article 25;
- (5) the manner in which and the time within which the charge should be paid;
- (6) a statement that it is an offence under this Order and Section 35(4) of the 1984 Act for the driver of a vehicle, having left a vehicle in a parking place to fail to pay the excess charge or charges in respect thereof; and
- (7) in the case of a vehicle attached to a motor vehicle, a notice (or notices) shall be attached to the motor vehicle drawing it in respect of either, or both, the motor vehicle and the other vehicle.
- 26. The particulars as to the times at which the ticket was obtained from a ticket machine specified on the ticket issued by parking apparatus, and affixed in accordance with the provisions of Article 6(3) of this Order, shall be evidence of the particulars so specified.
