THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (LOW FELLSIDE, KENDAL) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR ACCESS AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2002

The County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 29th July 2002 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Low Fellside, Kendal) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Except for Access and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2002
- Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed in any part of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order if the vehicle is:-
 - (a) Being used in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to, that length of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) The removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (iii) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road;
 - (iv) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to, that length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (v) Mechanical street cleansing or refuse collection.
 - (b) Being used for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
 - (c) Being used in the service of a local authority or a water or sewage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- 4. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths or road or sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 5. The Council is satisfied that for preventing the likelihood of danger arising to persons or other traffic using the road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order it is requisite that Section 3(1|) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
- 7. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of Driving

<u>Road</u>

Extent of Restriction

U808 Low Fellside

That length of Low Fellside situated at a point 35m south of the centre of its junction with Fountain Brow, southwards for a distance of 4m.

SCHEDULE 2

No Waiting At Any Time

<u>Road</u>

Extent of Restriction

U808 Low Fellside

West Side - the whole of the turning head immediately adjacent to and on the north side of Fellside Methodist Church;

East Side - from a point 64m north of the centre of its junction with Middle Lane, northwards for a distance of 7m.
