## THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA) (CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002) VARIATION ORDER (No.5) 2004

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2004 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) Variation Order (No.5) 2004
- 2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2002 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
- 3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though: -
  - (a) The following entry in Part 4 of Schedule 109 "One-Way Traffic" was deleted: -

Church Street, Bowness Both Sides From its junction with Fallbarrow Road to its junction with Lowside from south-west to north-east

(b) The following entry was added to Part 1 of Schedule 89 "Prohibition of Motor Vehicles": -

Bowness-on- Church Prohibition of Both Sides From a point 11 metres
Windermere Street Motor Vehicles north east of the centre
line of Fallbarrow
Road for a distance of
30 metres in an north
easterly direction

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
