## THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA) (CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002) (B5271 WINDERMERE ROAD, GRANGE-OVER-SANDS TO LINDALE) VARIATION ORDER 2007

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 2 April 2007 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (B5271 Windermere Road, Grange-over-Sands to Lindale) Variation Order 2007
- 2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2002 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
- 3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though: -
  - (a) the following was added to Schedule 95A "Weight Restriction Not Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes": -

Grange-over- Sands and Lindale	B5271	Windermere Road	From its junction with the B5277 in Grange-over-Sands to its junction with the C5046 (old A590) Lindale Hill in Lindale

- (b) The following was added as Article 134AA: -
- 134AA. Nothing in Article 134A shall apply to vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes proceeding along that length of the B5271 Windermere Road between Grange-over-Sands and Lindale providing they are being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road.
