

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA)  
(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)  
(VARIOUS ROADS, SEDBERGH) VARIATION ORDER 2011

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 14 March 2011 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Various Roads, Sedbergh) Variation Order 2011
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2002 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though: -
  - (a) the following were added to Schedule 52 Part 5 – Miscellaneous “No Waiting At Any Time”:-

<u>Town / Street</u> <u>Village Name</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Restricted Length</u>
Sedbergh Bainbridge Road	North	From the east side of its junction with Howgill Lane eastwards for a distance of 12m.
Sedbergh Bainbridge Road	South & West	From the west side of its junction with Joss Lane westwards, then northwards, then westwards for a distance of 58m (following the kerb line).
Sedbergh Howgill junction Lane/ north Bainbridge of Road	East & South	From the north side of its junction with Highfield Road in a easterly direction for distance  18m .
Sedbergh Castlehaw	Both	From the north side of its junction with Long Lane northwards for a distance of 13m.
Sedbergh Fairholme	Northwest	From the east side of its junction with Howgill Lane north-eastwards for a distance of 7m.
Sedbergh Fairholme	Southeast	From the east side of its junction with Howgill Lane north-eastwards for a distance of 15m (following the kerb line)
Sedbergh Howgill Lane	West	From the north side of its junction with Highfield Road northwards for a distance of 9m.

Sedbergh	Howgill the Lane	West	From a point 12m north of north side of its junction with Fairholme southwards for a distance of 27m.
Sedbergh	Howgill north Lane	East	From its junction with the side of Fairholme northwards for a distance of 10m.
Sedbergh	Howgill junction Lane	East	From the south side of its with Fairholme to the north side of its junction with Bainbridge Road.
Sedbergh	Long Lane	North	From a point 12m west of the west side of its junction with Castlehaw to a point 12m east of the east side of its junction with Castlehaw.
Sedbergh	Long Lane	North	From a point 34m east of the east side of its junction with Castlehaw eastwards for a distance of 15m.
Sedbergh	Loftus Hill	East	From a point 12m north of the north side of its junction with Winder Drive to a point 12m south of the south side of its junction with Winder Drive.

(b) The following was added as Article 88(12)(A): -

88(12)(A) between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm, on a Monday to Friday inclusive,  
in the lengths of road or sides of road specified in Schedule 63A to this Order.

(c) The following was added as Schedule 63A: -

INCLUSIVE  
PART 1 – MISCELLANEOUS**

Sedbergh	Bainbridge Road	North & East	From the west side of its junction with Joss Lane westwards then northwards for a distance of 40m (following wall boundary line)

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
