## THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA) (CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002) (KIRKBY LONSDALE) VARIATION ORDER 2013

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 30 September 2013 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Kirkby Lonsdale) Variation Order 2013
- 2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2002 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
