

**THE SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL (MARKET PLACE LOADING BAY)
(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) ORDER 2007**

The Council of the Borough of South Tyneside (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, and 2, 3 and 4 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and by virtue of The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of South Tyneside) Order 2006 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 17 December 2007 and may be cited as "The South Tyneside Council (Market Place, Loading Bay)(Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2007".

Amendments to The South Tyneside Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)(Consolidation) (No.3) Order 2007

2. The South Tyneside Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) (No. 3) Order 2007 is amended as follows:
3. In Schedule 1.01, Item number 181 relating to Market Place South Shields, the north side (i) and (ii) are deleted and replaced with the following new rows:
 - ' (i) from its junction with the western boundary of the Market Place in an easterly direction for a distance of 6.5 metres;
 - (ii) from a point 12.5 metres east of its junction with the western boundary of the Market Place, in an easterly direction for a distance of 42.5 metres'.
4. In Schedule 3.01, Item number 55 relating to Market Place South Shields, the north side (i) the words "4 metres" are replaced with the words "6 metres"
5. In Schedule 6.02, Item number 5 relating to Market Place South Shields, the north side (ii) the words "4 metres" are replaced with the words "6.5 metres".
