

THE SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL (SUNDERLAND ROAD LOADING BAY) (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) ORDER 2007

The Council of the Borough of South Tyneside (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, and 2, 3 and 4 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and by virtue of The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of South Tyneside) Order 2006 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 17 December 2007 and may be cited as “The South Tyneside Council (Sunderland Road, Loading Bay)(Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2007”.

Amendments to The South Tyneside Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)(Consolidation) (No.3) Order 2007

2. The South Tyneside Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) (No. 3) Order 2007 is amended as follows:
 3. In Schedule 2.01, Item number 43 relating to Sunderland Road South Shields, both sides (i) is revoked in its entirety.
 4. In Schedule 2.01, after Item number 43 relating to Sunderland Road South Shields, the east side (i) insert the following new row:-

“(ii) from the junction with Prince Edward Road northwards for a distance of 100 metres.”
 5. In Schedule 2.01, after Item number 43 relating to Sunderland Road South Shields, the west side (i) insert the following new rows:-

“(ii) from the junction with Prince Edward Road northwards for a distance of 58 metres.

(iii) from a point 78 metres North of its junction with Prince Edward Road Northwards for a distance of 22 metres”.
 6. In Schedule 6.01, after Item number 12 relating to Station Road Hebburn, insert the following new row:-

“13. Sunderland Road South Shields the west side:-
(i) from a point 58 metres north of its junction with Prince

Edward Road in a northerly
direction for 20 metres”
