

SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL

(ON STREET PARKING PAY AND DISPLAY) (DAYS OF OPERATION)

ORDER 2008

The Council of the Borough of South Tyneside Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1,2,32,33, 35, 45, 46, and 49 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and under the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area)(Metropolitan Borough of South Tyneside) Order 2006 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order :-

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order may be cited as "South Tyneside Council (On Street Parking Pay and Display) (Days of Operation) Order 2008" and shall come into force on 9 February 2008
2. The South Tyneside Council (Parking Places) (Consolidation) (No.3) Order 2007 is hereby varied as follows:
3. In Part II, Section A, Article 2 after sub paragraph 2 b) insert the following new lines:
4. " b i) Save as provided in paragraphs (c) and (d) of this Article, each of the parts of road specified in Schedule 22.03 of this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Article and of Section B of this Order as a parking place between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Mondays to Sundays inclusive for the parking of such classes of vehicle as are specified in column 3 of that Schedule and on payment of such charge as is specified in relation to each length of road in column 6 of the said Schedule".
5. In Part II, Section A, Article 2 c) after the words "paragraphs a), b)" insert "bi).

6. In Part II, Section A Article 2 d) after the words “paragraphs a), b)” insert “bi).
7. In Part II, Section A Article 2 f) after the words “Schedules 22.01 and 22.02” insert “and Schedule 22.03”
8. In Part II, Section A Article 2 g) after the words “Schedules 22.01 or 22.02” insert “or Schedule 22.03”
9. In Part II, Section A Article 2 j) ii) after the words “Schedules 22.01 or 22.02” insert “or Schedule 22.03”
10. In Schedule 22.01 item numbers 1 to 12 inclusive are deleted in their entirety.
11. After Schedule 22.02 relating to Pay and Display 9.30am – 8.30 pm insert Schedule One to this Order.
