THE SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL (WHARTON STREET SOUTH SHIELDS) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2008

The Council of the Borough of South Tyneside (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4(2) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and by virtue of The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of South Tyneside) Order 2006 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and Citation

 This Order shall come into operation on 21 January 2008 and may be cited as "The South Tyneside Council (Wharton Street South Shields) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2008".

Amendments to The South Tyneside Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)(Consolidation) (No.3) Order 2007

- 2. The South Tyneside Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) (No. 3) Order 2007 is amended as follows:
- 3. In Schedule 1.01, Item number 370 relating to Wharton Street South Shields, both sides (i) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following words

"Wharton Street, South Shields

north side - from the east kerb of Westoe Road in an easterly direction to East Back Westoe Road;

south side – from the east kerb of Westoe Road for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction".

- 4. In Schedule 2.01, Item number 56 relating to Wharton Street South Shields, delete the words "both sides" and replace with the words "south side".
- 5. In Schedule 4.03, Item number 9 relating to Wharton Street South Shields, both sides is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following words

"Wharton Street, South Shields north side - from the east kerb of Westoe Road in an easterly direction to East Back Westoe Road:

south side – from the east kerb of Westoe Road for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction".
