

Off Street Parking Order  
SOUTH LAKELAND DISTRICT COUNCIL

The South Lakeland District Council (herein after referred to as 'the council') in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (herein after referred to as 'the 1984 Act') and all enabling powers in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part iii of schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PART 1  
GENERAL

1. This order shall come into operation on...7<sup>th</sup> June 2004 and may be cited as the South Lakeland District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2004 .

All previous orders in relation to 'Off street Parking places' shall be revoked.

2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. In this order the Act of 1984 means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

(SI No 683) 2000 Regulations means the local authorities traffic orders (Exemptions for disabled persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000.

(SI No 682)2000 Regulations means the disabled persons (Badges for motor vehicle) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended by the disabled persons (Badges for motor vehicles) (England) (amendment) Regulations 2000.

4. The South Lakeland District Council (Off street Parking Places)(charges) Order means the current South Lakeland District Council (Off Street Parking Places )(Charges) Order 2004 whether as either amended by order, varied by notice under Section 35c of the Act of 1984, or not amended or varied, which ever the case may be.

5. 'Ambulance' has the same meaning as in paragraph 6(2) of schedule 2 of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994

6. 'Authorised goods vehicle' means a vehicle of a class specified in the schedule of this order.

7. 'Authorised classes of vehicle' means a vehicle of a class specified in the schedule to this order

8. 'Causes' includes permits.

9. 'Charging hours' means any period for which a parking charge is specified in the current schedule to this Order as either amended, varied or not as the case may be.

10. 'Contract parking ticket' means a ticket issued by the council or the written permission of the council authorising the parking of a designated vehicle upon a named parking place, subject to such conditions as may from time to time be fixed by the council.

11. 'Council' means the Council of the South Lakeland District

12. 'Disabled person's badge' has the same meaning as in (SI No 682) Regulation 2000.

13. 'Disabled persons vehicle' has the same meaning as in the (SI No 683) Regulations 2000.

14. 'Dispensation' means an authorisation in writing issued by an authorised officer of the council which entitles a specified vehicle to wait in a parking place, specified in the schedule, while either it's operation or a condition of it's use is suspended .

15. 'Driver' in relation to a motor vehicle waiting in a parking place' means the person driving the motor vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place and in relation to a trailer, boat trailer or other non mechanically propelled vehicle means the driver of the motor vehicle by which that trailer, boat trailer or other vehicle is being drawn at the time of parking.

16. 'Enactment' means any enactment whether public, local or general and includes any order, bye law, rule, regulation or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.

17. 'Goods Vehicle' means the same as in the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994.

18. 'Motor Car' means and includes any mechanically propelled vehicle not being a motor cycle or an invalid carriage, which is constructed itself to carry passengers of which the weight unladen does not normally exceed 3050 kilograms, subject always to the inclusion of the extended meaning to this term given in Section 136 of the 1984 Act (and whether or not it is being used for business purposes).

19. 'Motor Vehicle' means a mechanically propelled vehicle.

20. 'Obstruction' means leaving a motor vehicle in such a position, or such a condition, or in such circumstances in a parking place, as to cause obstruction to other persons using the parking place, or as to be likely to cause danger to such persons.

21. 'Parking Attendant' means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to authorise the alteration of the position or removal of a vehicle in or from the parking place, issue penalty charge notices and enforce the provisions of this order.

22. 'Parking Disc' has the same meaning as in regulation 8(5) of (SI No 683) Regulations Order

23. 'Parking space' means a space in the parking place marked on the surface of the parking place by lines, markings or indicated by signs which is provided for the parking of vehicles.

24. 'Parking Place' means an area of land specified by name in column 1 of the schedule to this order and provided by the council under Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act as a Parking Place.

25. 'Parking Place notice or tariff board' means a notice displayed in a parking place which describes the conditions contained in this order under which a vehicle may be left in a parking place.

26. 'Parking ticket' means a ticket issued by means of a ticket machine within a parking place that indicates the payment of a charge and the time at which the ticket ceases to be valid.

27. 'Permit' means a permit issued by the council in accordance with the provisions of the current SLDC (parking places) (charges order) entitling a vehicle to park in a parking place without displaying a parking ticket.

28. 'Public Service Vehicle' means a vehicle constructed or adapted for the carriage of passengers and their effects.

29. 'Relevant position' in relation to a ticket, permit or any dispensation issued in accordance with a provision of this order, means exhibited on the windscreen of the vehicle, or where the vehicle is not fitted with a windscreen, exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front of the vehicle so that it is clearly legible to a person standing adjacent to the front of the vehicle.

30. 'Relevant position' in relation to a disabled parking badge or parking disc has the same meaning as in the (SI No 683) Regulation 2000.

31. 'Restricted Area' means that part of the parking place marked on the surface and or with other signs indicating that it is a restricted area.

32. 'Trailer' means the same as Section 185 Road Traffic Act 1988

33. 'Vehicle' has the same meaning as in Section 62(1) of the Vehicle Excise and Regulation Act 1994

34. Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated or re-enacted by, or as having the effect, by the virtue of any subsequent enactment.

35. Any reference in this order to a numbered article or schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this order.

## **PART 2**

### **USE OF PARKING PLACES**

1. The named areas of land specified in the schedule to this order and hereby authorised to be used subject to the following provisions of this order as parking places for such classes of vehicles as are specified in the schedule to this order.

2. Save as provided in article 7 (i), or unless directed by a Parking Attendant, no person shall cause any vehicle to wait in a parking place specified in the schedule during its hours of operation unless it displays in the relevant position a valid parking ticket, a contract parking permit, permit or dispensation for that parking place, at that time.

3. A vehicle which waits within a parking place specified in the schedule in contravention of this article will be subject to the issue of a penalty charge, the amount of which will be as set in accordance with the current notification published under the directions of the Secretary of State and in operation under the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Lakeland District Council) Order 2001.

4. The charge for a vehicle left in a parking place specified in the schedule during the operating hours for that parking place is specified in the current South Lakeland District Council (Parking Places) (Charges) Order or where that parking charge has been varied under Section 35c of the Act of 1984, at the relevant parking place. The driver of a vehicle or other person on the driver's behalf shall on leaving the vehicle in a parking space and on each separate occasion, the vehicle is left in the parking place proceed immediately on foot to the ticket machine and pay the appropriate parking charge and display the said ticket in the relevant position in the vehicle.

5(i.) A parking ticket previously purchased by another driver and displayed on a vehicle is not valid for any other vehicle it is transferred to. Should this situation arise, it shall be deemed that the vehicle to which it is transferred will not be displaying a valid pay and display ticket.

5(ii.) A previously purchased pay and display ticket that is still valid shall be transferable to another parking place, provided that the parking place has the same monetary tariff or lower. Should it be found that the tariff is

higher than the pay and display ticket purchased it shall be deemed that the vehicle is not displaying a valid pay and display ticket.

6(i). Where a vehicle has displayed a parking ticket for less than the maximum period of waiting permitted, as indicated by the tariff board, a further ticket may be purchased and displayed on that vehicle, provided that it is purchased and displayed prior to the expiry of the original ticket and that the time stated on the subsequent ticket is not exceeded.

(ii) Where more than one ticket has been purchased and displayed prior to the expiry of the original ticket, the total cost of tickets purchased must not be less than the cost of one ticket for the same waiting period relevant to that parking space.

7. No person shall allow a motor vehicle to remain in a parking space beyond the expiry time indicated by the pay and display ticket, which is displayed in that vehicle in any parking place mentioned in this schedule. Any vehicle that displays a disabled persons badge in the relevant position is exempt from:-

- i. A parking charge to be paid for a vehicle left in a parking area specified in the schedule.
- ii. For the purposes of this order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled persons badge and parking disc if they are issued in accordance with regulation 4 & 7 of the (SI No 682) 2000 regulations and are:
  - a) Displayed in accordance with Regulation 14 of the (SI No 682) 2000 Regulations.
  - b) Displayed in the relevant position and:
  - c) Currently in force.

8. In relation to a 'short stay' parking place having a limited waiting period, no vehicle shall remain longer in a parking space than the maximum period specified in the schedule and no vehicle so parked shall return to that space, parking place or any part thereof within 1 hour of the expiry of the maximum waiting period. This shall also apply to the holder of a disabled blue or orange badge, or other permit. The driver of the vehicle shall set the parking disc at the arrival time.

9. A vehicle shall not wait in a parking place other than entirely within a parking space, except with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant.

- i. A vehicle shall not wait in any area of a parking place that is restricted by surface markings or other signs nor shall it be left in such a position in a parking place so as to cause any unnecessary obstruction.
- ii. A vehicle shall not be driven on a parking place other than in the direction indicated by surface marking and or other signs displayed or other than on the direction of a Parking Attendant or Police Constable in Uniform.

10. Where within a parking place specified in the schedule there is a sign or surface marking which indicates a parking space is available only for use by disabled badge holders:-

- a) No vehicle shall stand or wait in that parking space unless it displays in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge and parking disc.
- b) No person shall cause any vehicle to remain in such a parking space within a parking place for longer than the maximum period of waiting permitted and shall display the time disc set at the time of arrival in the relevant position.
- c) Save as the conditions in 8 above, these shall apply in respect of disabled blue or orange badge holders regarding the maximum waiting period for that parking place.

11. Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates a parking space is available for use only by permit holders, no vehicle shall stand or wait in such a parking space unless it is an authorised vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid permit for that parking place at that time. This shall apply to vehicles displaying a disabled blue or orange badge and motor cycles, unless they also display a valid permit.

12(i). Where there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that an area or parking space, within a parking place is available only for use as a loading bay or other specific use, no person shall except upon the direction of a constable in uniform or of a parking attendant cause any vehicle to stand or wait within that area other than an authorised goods vehicle to be loaded thereon or unloaded there-from or for any class of vehicle other than that which is indicated on the signs to park therein.

(ii) No person shall cause to be parked on any parking area within this schedule any trailer (as defined in section 158 Road Traffic Act 1988) without the express permission of a Constable in uniform or Parking Attendant unless it is on a parking area and in a parking space set-aside for the parking of trailers and providing the appropriate fee as shown in the schedule has been paid and the ticket displayed upon the drawing vehicle.

13. No person shall without the written consent of the Council and subject to such conditions as the Council from time to time decide:-

- i. Use any parking place in connection with any commercial activity, or advertisement or sale of any article to persons in or near the car park, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services; or
- ii. Erect cause to be erected any tent or booth, stand or other structure; or
- iii. Use any vehicle while it is in the parking area for camping, cooking or picnicking or lighting of fires;
- iv. Use a parking place as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another.
- v. No person shall abandon on any parking place within the schedule any 'thing' or vehicle which has been brought to that parking place for the purpose of abandoning it.
- vi. No person shall leave any vehicle in any parking area in the schedule when the parking area is deemed to be closed by the council as indicated by signs and or physical barriers placed by the council.
- vii. No person shall in a parking place use threatening abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.



- viii. No person shall, in any parking place damage or interfere with the fabric, structures, apparatus or equipment of any parking place.
- ix. No person shall in a parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.
- x. No person shall without lawful authority or express permission deposit or carry in a vehicle any harmful, hazardous, caustic, inflammable or noxious substance on any parking place within the schedule.
- xi. No person shall cause a motor vehicle to enter any part of a parking place which exceeds the height and weight restrictions applicable to that parking place specified in the schedule, except with permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Parking Attendant.

#### Duty to deliver up a Document

14. A parking attendant or the council's head of parking services is hereby authorised to act in accordance with section 116 of the Act of 1984.

#### Suspension of Parking Place

- 15 (i) Nothing in this order shall restrict the power of the Council by notice, to suspend the operation of a parking place or any part thereof, in order to prevent the obstruction of adjoining streets on the occasion of any public procession or other occasion where adjoining streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed and when the operation of a parking place or part thereof is suspended, the Council shall display a notice or notices to that effect at that parking place and at the ticket machines.
- (ii) When the operation of a parking place is suspended pursuant to paragraph (i) above, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, stand or wait in a car park or any part thereof for the duration of the suspension, except for an ambulance or any other vehicle used in the service of a fire brigade or police force, or to any vehicle so left with written permission of;
- (a) A police constable in uniform or:

(b) An authorised officer of the Council.

16 (i) Nothing in this order shall restrict the power of the Council at its absolute discretion, to suspend the public operation of a parking place specified in the schedule or any part thereof and or a condition of use, for operational or other reasons, in such circumstances when the operation of a parking place specified in the schedule or part thereof has its public operation or condition of use suspended. The Council shall display a notice or other notices to that effect at the parking place or part thereof.

(ii) When a parking place specified in the schedule or part thereof has its operation and or a condition of its use suspended as above, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter, stand or wait in that parking place or part thereof and or contravene a condition of its use during the operation of the suspension unless the vehicle has a valid dispensation issued by the Council.

(iii) When a car park specified in the schedule or part thereof, has its operation and or condition of its use suspended in pursuance to paragraph above, the Council shall at the end of such period, display a notice or notices to that effect at the parking place.

17 (i) Subject to the times specified at the locations referred to in the schedule, no person shall without the express permission of a Police Constable in Uniform or Parking attendant leave a motor vehicle parked and unattended at any site designated as a Market site or while the parking area is suspended as indicated by signs.

(ii) Any vehicle which is in contravention of the above order may be liable for removal by a person authorised by the council and the reasonable costs of the removal and storage of that vehicle incurred by the council or their agent shall:-

(a) Be paid by the driver or owner of the vehicle, or

(b) May be recovered from the driver or owner as a civil debt.

(iii) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised on behalf of the council, or a police constable in uniform, may alter, or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place, or remove, or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.

- (iv) Any authorised person altering, or causing the alteration of, the position of a vehicle or removing, or causing the removal of a vehicle may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or moving it in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed. Neither such persons nor the council shall be responsible for loss of, or damage to the vehicle, or of or to anything contained therein and thereon arising from, or in consequence of the powers contained in this order.

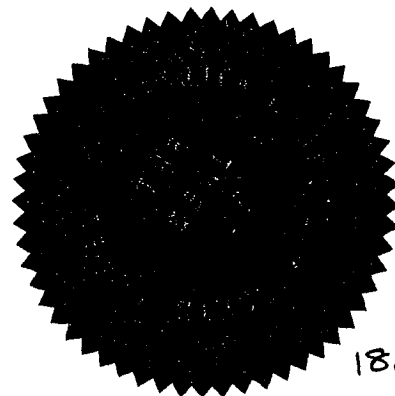
